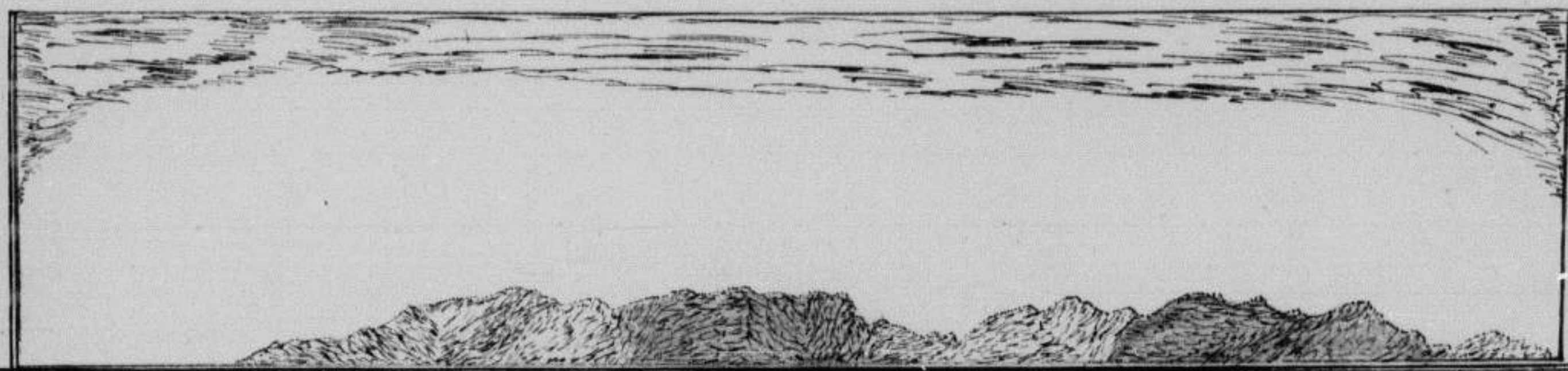


Ship Lion, Cruising on the Line in 1842

Latter the same Lat 22° Long 170. 42. 15

Tuesday November 1st
Sine from the SE Steering N by E middle fine latter the same
at 6 AM saw the island of Cambourus so called
Lat 21. 05 Long 171. 33. 15



Wednesday November 2nd
Sine from the SE Steering N by E & Edenborough in sight
middle fine latter the same Lat 21. 11 Long 171. 58. 30

Thursday November 3rd
Sine from the SE Steering N by E at 8 PM saw the Island
of Saint Marges extending from SE to NE 50 miles middle
and latter the same the island of St Marges in sight
Lat 25.0 Long 172. 13. 15

Saturday November 5th
Sine from the SE on the wind to the SE nothing in sight
middle and latter the same at 8 AM saw a ship whaling
at 8 AM saw the whales the she was in chase of two
but did not fasten the being galled by the ships boats
Lat 19. 09 Long 172. 41. 30



Sunday November 6th
Sine from the SE on the wind to the north one ship in sight
and whales to the windward middle and latter the same
Lat 17. 0 Long 172. 47. 00

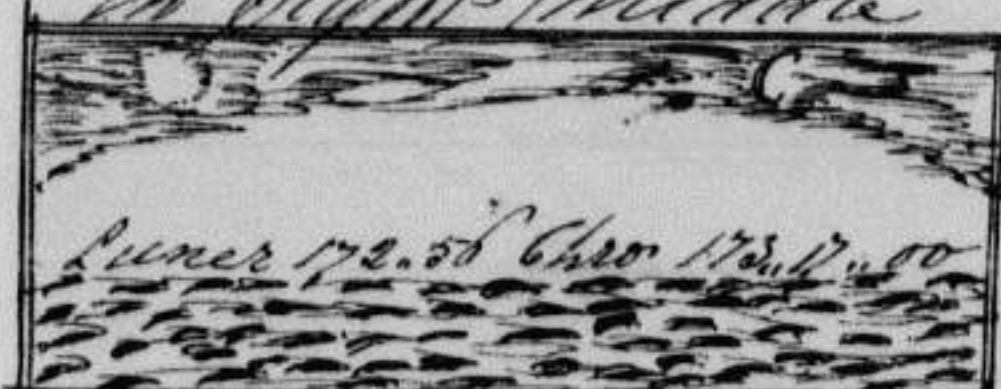
Monday November 7th
Sine from the SE on the wind to the south the Peninsula
of London N. W. 250 ships oil middle and latter the same
Lat 16. 0 Long 172. 52. 30



Tuesday November 8th
Sine from the SE on the wind to the north middle and latter
the same Lat 14. 10 Long 173. 12. 00



Wednesday November 9th
Sine from the SE on the wind to the north the Peninsula
in sight middle and latter the same Lat 21. 0 Long 173. 17. 00



Thursday November 10th
Sine from the SE on the wind to the SE one sail in sight
middle and latter the same
Lat 1. 24 Long 173. 03. 15
