Wind from the S.W. on the wind to the north nothing in sight Middle and later the same Lat 1.8 Long 179.41.50

Monday Decem 18th

Light from the S.W. steering S.W. nothing in sight Middle and later the same Lat 1.00 Long 179.17.50 East

Tuesday Decem 19th

Light from the S.W. on the wind to the S.W. nothing in sight Middle and later strong gale Lat and Long none

Wednesday Decem 20th

Strong gale from the S.W. lying under close reefed Main Foremast Middle the same later more moderate

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Thursday Decem 15th

Wind from the North steering S.W. nothing in sight Middle and later the same Lat 2.55 Long 179.59.50

Friday Decem 16th

Wind from the N.W. steering S.W. nothing in sight Middle and later the same Lat 2.17 Long 178.40.50

Saturday Decem 17th

Wind from the S.W. steering S.W. sent our finback Middle and later strong Lat 6.10 South Long none

Sunday Decem 18th

Strong with heavy squalls of rain and wind nothing in sight Middle and later the same Lat 6.08 Long 177.47.50

Monday Decem 19th

Strong with squalls of rain the wind S.W. steering S.W. Middle and later the same Lat 7.04 Long 177.40.50

Tuesday Decem 20th

Light and calm steering S.W. nothing in sight Middle and later the same at 11 am sent a sperm whale a going jick lower six not faster Lat 7.40 Long 177.00.50
