Thursday Decem 22nd

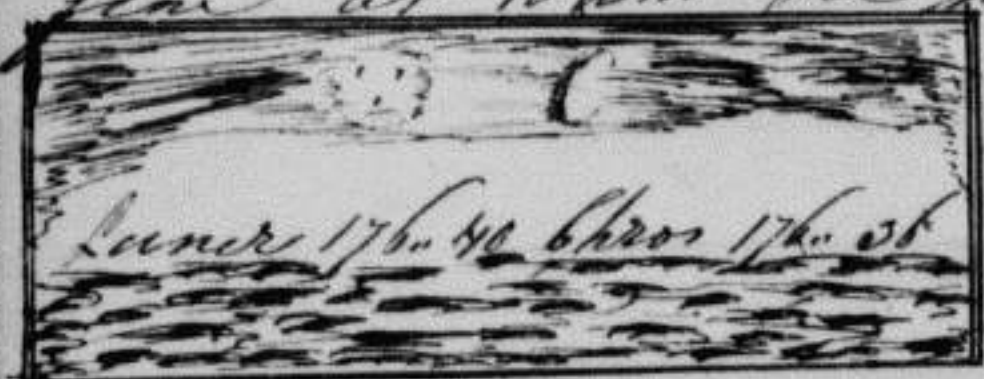
Light from the North showing S by S nothing in sight
Middle and later the same Lat 41.9 Long 17. 54.15

Friday Decem 23rd

Strong from the West nothing in sight steering South
Middle and later S by W Lat 41.03 Long 17. 52. 30

Saturday Decem 24th

fine from the N by W steering South Middle and later
fine at 10 AM the wind hauled to the South Lat 41.55 Long 17.36



Sunday Decem 25th

fine from the S by E on the wind to the west nothing in
sight Middle and later the same Lat Long none

Monday December 26th

Light and calm steering South Middle and later the same
Lat 41.28 Long 17. 44. 30

Tuesday December 27th

fine from the SE on the wind to the SE nothing in sight
Middle and later the same Lat 42.03 Long 17. 57. 2

Wednesday December 28th

Light from the SE on the wind to the SE nothing in
sight Middle and later the same Lat
Lat 42.49 Long 17. 56. 30

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Thursday December 29th

Light from the SE on the wind to the South nothing in sight
Middle and later the same Lat 43.21 Long 17. 52. 30



Friday December 30th

Light from the SE steering N by E & Pelee's Island in sight
Middle and later the same Lat 43.27 Long 17. 55. 30

Saturday December 31st

Light standing in for the land Middle fine later
the same at 8 PM went on shore after wood and water so ends

Sunday January 1st

fine from the SE at 7 AM fetched of one boat load of wood
Middle fine later the same saw whales & seals

Monday January 2nd

fine from the SE all hands employed in getting wood
at 6 fetched of stock loads so ends the 24 hours

Tuesday January 3rd

fine with rain and wind Middle and later the same
the island of Pelee in sight
