Light from the ESE on the wind to the North

Sunday June 18th

Light from the North on the wind to the
East nothing in sight middle and later calm

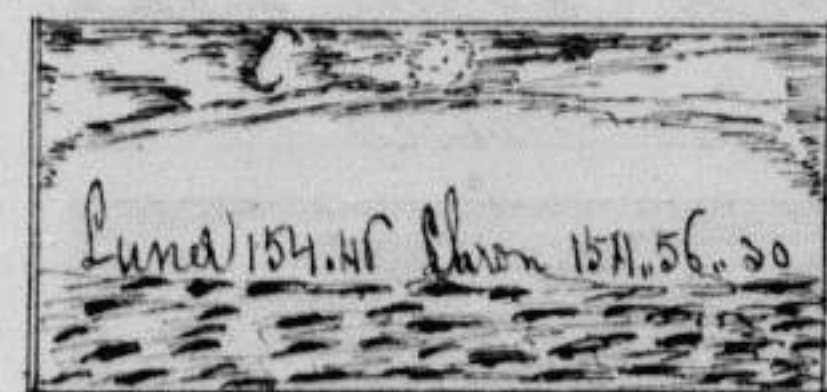


Monday June 19th
