middle and later fine at 6 AM saw whales lower part
and killed one whale and misca another

Friday July 28th

Wind from the S.E. at 11 AM saw sperm whales lower and
killed one whale middle a booby middle
a bird Lat the same with rain Lat 18 S Long 176 54 30

Saturday July 29th

Light and calm saw Breaches middle fine later
the same Lat 21 S Long 176 48 30

Sunday July 30th

Light from the E on the wind to the S.E. middle and later
the same Lat 23 S Long 176 30 30

Monday July 31st

Wind from the S.E. steering south nothing in sight middle
and later strong at 1 AM saw sperm whales lower
part to four whales and killed them



Lat 25 Long 176 38 30

Tuesday August 1st

Strong from the S.E. employed in cutting at 1/2 past 4
finished middle booby later the same

Lat 22 S Long 177 15 45

Wednesday August 2nd

Strong from the S.E. on the wind to the North employed
in booby middle the same Lat 18 S

Lat 53 S Long 177 27 30

Thursday August 3rd

Light from E on the wind to the S.E. middle and later
the same Lat 23 S Long 177 41 30

Friday August 4th

Light air from E on the wind to the S nothing in sight
middle and later the same Lat 19 S Long 177 58 30

Saturday August 5th

Wind from the E.S.E. on the wind to the S.E. nothing in
sight middle and later the same Lat 21 S Long 177 25 30

Sunday August 6th

Wind from the E.S.E. on the wind to the S nothing
in sight middle and later squalls of rain

Lat 18 S Long 177 29 30

Monday August 7th

Fresh with squalls of rain on the wind to the S nothing
in sight middle and later the same Lat 18 S Long 177 32 30

Tuesday August 8th

Strong from the S.E. on the wind to the S middle and later
the same Lat 18 S Long 177 28 30
