Lat 6.24 Long 180. 00.00

Tuesday Sept 5th

Strong from the SE on the wind to the SE  
nothing in sight Middle and later the same  
Lat 6.06 Long 179. 26. 34

Wednesday Sept 6th

Strong from the SE on the wind to the SE  
nothing in sight Middle and later the same  
Lat 6.48 Long 179. 28. 00

Thursday Sept 7th

Light and backing nothing in sight Middle and  
later the same Lat 7.20 Long 178. 58. 30

Friday Sept 8th

Light and calm nothing in sight Middle and  
later the same Lat 7.23 Long 178. 38. 30

Saturday Sept 9th

Light on the wind to the SE nothing in sight  
Middle and later the same Lat 8.35 Long 178. 22. 30

Sunday Sept 10th

Strong with squalls of rain nothing in sight Middle  
and later the same Lat 10.00 Long 178. 18. 50

Monday Sept 11th

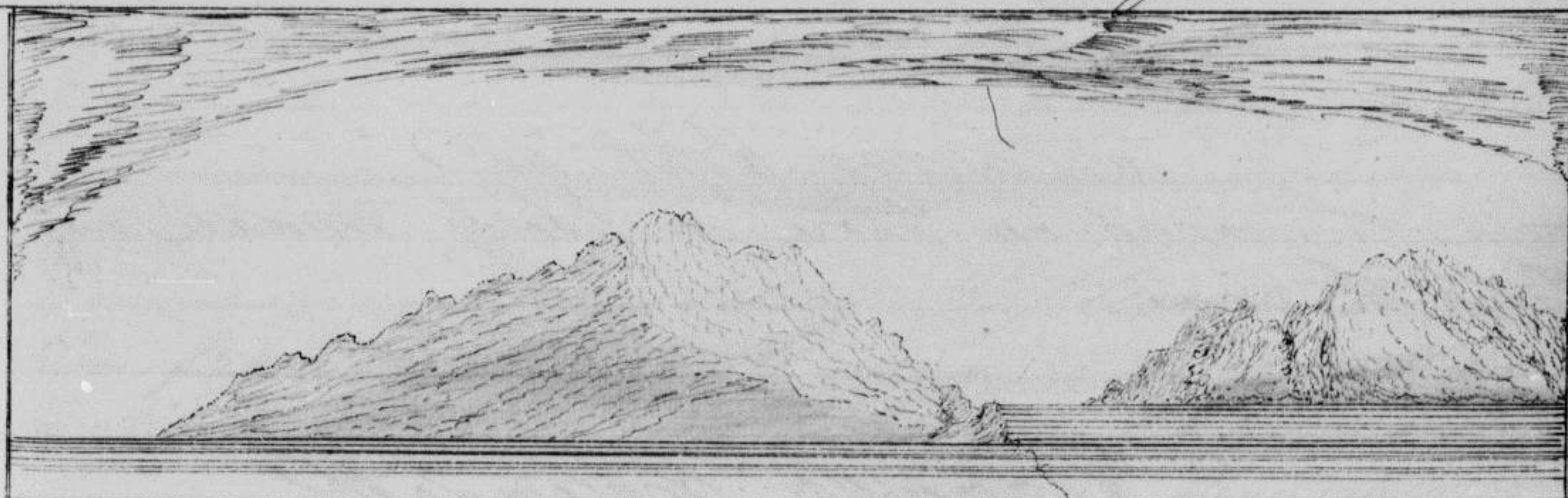
Strong trades from the East on the wind to the SE  
Middle and later the same Lat 11.48 Long 178. 17. 15

Tuesday Sept 12th

Strong from the East starting SE by nothing in sight  
Middle and later the same Lat 13.17 Long 178. 06. 50

Wednesday Sept 13th

Strong gales from the E on the wind to the SE under  
sudden squalls to the Middle the same later  
more moderate at 7 PM saw the Island Horn  
Lat 14 Long 178. 03. 15



Thursday Sept 14th

More moderate from the East beating up to the  
Middle Middle and later the same at 9 AM went  
on shore so ends these 24 hours
