Friday Sept 15th

Strong from the S.E. at 3 pm sent a raft of oak on shore
made and later the same

Saturday Sept 16th

More moderate the boat came on board with game
made and later the same took the raft on shore
and sent a notice raft on shore

Sunday Sept 17th

Fin the boat came of with recruits and wood
made and later the same one week on shore at liberty

Monday Sept 18th

Fin from the E one week on shore made and
later the same finished of the other raft of water
and the remainder of wood and recruits

Tuesday Sept 19th

Fin the week on shore on liberty made and
later the same

Wednesday Sept 20th

Fin from the S.E. the week on shore made
and later the same

Thursday Sept 21st

Fin from the S.E. at 8 pm the boat came
on board were ship to the S.E.

Ship Lion on her Passage to the French Peak

Friday Sept 22nd

Fin on the wind to the S.E. made and later
the same Lat 15.36 Long 178.22.15

Saturday Sept 23rd

Fin from the East at 2 pm sent 4 sperm whales to
fasten killed the whale took him along side
for the night made and later the same
at 5 AM hooked down at 7 AM finished cutting
Lat 16.42 Long 178.03.30



Sunday Sept 24th

Fin employed in drying nothing in sight made
and later the same Lat 16.31 Long 177.33.30

Monday Sept 25th

Fin from the E.S. on the wind to the S.E. employed
in drying made and later the same Lat 16.42 Long 178.03.30

Tuesday Sept 26th

Fin from the S.E. on the wind to the S.E. nothing
in sight made and later fin Lat finished storm
Lat 16.12 Long 176.23.15

Wednesday Sept 27th

Light from the S.E. on the wind to the S.E. nothing
in sight made the same later fin at 7 am
saw the Island of Onkofu Lat 16.05 Long 175.44.15
