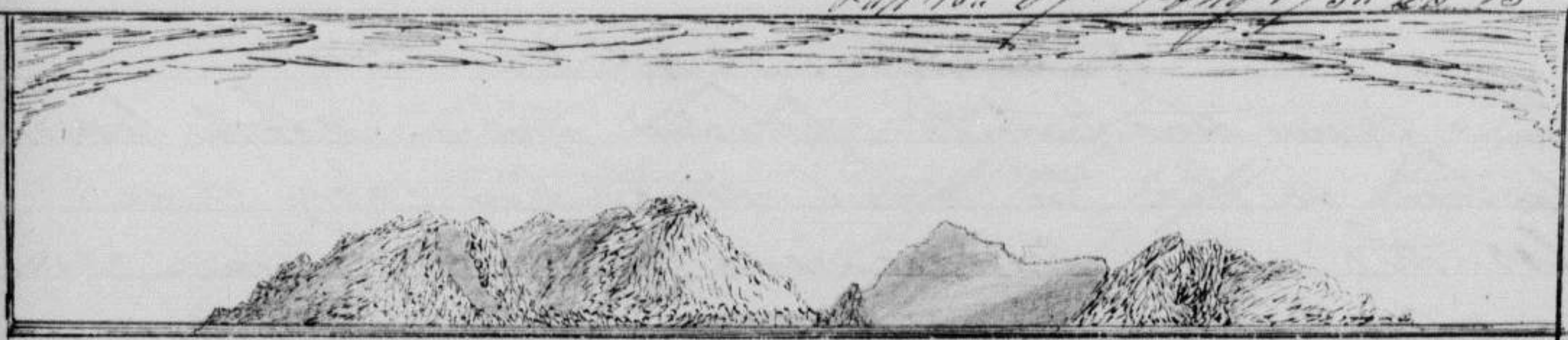

Sunday October 1st
 Strong from the S on the wind to the S. 40°
 nothing in sight Midday and later the same
 Lat 18. 56 Long 177. 18. 30



Monday October 2nd
 Fine from the S on the wind to the S. 40° nothing in
 sight at 6 pm saw sperm whale lower a feather to
 three whales killed them took them along side
 Midday the same Lat 19. 01 at 2 PM hooked a whale
 to the whale at 6 pm hooked Lat 19. 57 Long 177. 20. 15

Tuesday October 3rd
 Light employed in fishing at 3 pm saw sperm whale
 lower a but did not see him again Midday and
 strong singleauffed the top sails Lat 19. 13 Long 177. 16. 30

Wednesday October 4th
 Strong from the S on the wind to the S. 40° nothing
 in sight Midday strong with squalls of wind and rain
 later fine Lat 19. 16 Long 176. 32. 15

 Fine from the North on the wind to the S. 40° nothing
 in sight Midday and later same employed in fishing
 Lat 19. 16 Long 176. 43. 15

Friday October 6th
 Strong from the North on the wind to the S. 40°
 employed in fishing Midday and later strong
 Lat 19. 52 Long 176. 50. 15

Saturday October 7th
 Strong from the S on the wind to the S. 40°
 nothing in sight Midday and later the same
 Lat 19. 33 Long 176. 52. 30

Sunday October 8th
 Strong from the S on the wind to the S. 40° Midday
 and later the same Lat 19. 39 Long 176. 52. 30
