Time and pleasant weather from the SE steering SE by S
one sail in sight (middle) and later the same
Lat 30.58 Long 172. 15. 30

Wednesday December 7th

Strong from the SE steering SE nothing in sight (middle)
and later the same Lat 31.29 Long 174. 45. 15 East

Friday Decem 8th

Strong gales from the south steering SE nothing in
sight (middle) and later the same Lat 31.44 Long 176. 05. 15

Saturday December 9th

Strong gales from the South steering SE nothing
in sight (middle) and later more more moderate
Lat 32.19 Long 178. 14. 30 East

Sunday December 10th

Time from the SE on the wind to the SE one sail
in sight standing to the East (middle) and later
the same Lat 33. 37 Long 179. 08. 30 East

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Monday December 11th

Time from the SE steering on the wind to the south nothing
in sight (middle) and later the same Lat 34. 41 Long 182. 05. 15

Tuesday December 12th

Time from the ESE on the wind to the SE by S one sail
in sight (middle) and later the same Lat 35. 00 Long 183. 00. 00

Wednesday December 13th

Strong from the south with some rain at 4 p.m. spoke
the ship Sharon Capt Smith of Fair Haven 31 Months
ago from (middle) and later fine Lat 36. 11 Long 184. 45. 30

Friday December 14th

Time from the SE steering SE the Sharon in sight
(middle) and later the same Lat 38. 30 Long 187. 14. 15 East

Saturday December 15th

Time from the East on the wind to the SE the Sharon
in sight (middle) and later strong Lat 39. 14 Long 189. 01. 15

Sunday December 16th

Strong gales from the SE on the wind to the south the
Sharon in sight (middle) and later the same

Monday December 17th

Strong gales from the East on the wind to the
South (middle) and later the same Lat 39. 33 Long 190. 12
