and New Zealand

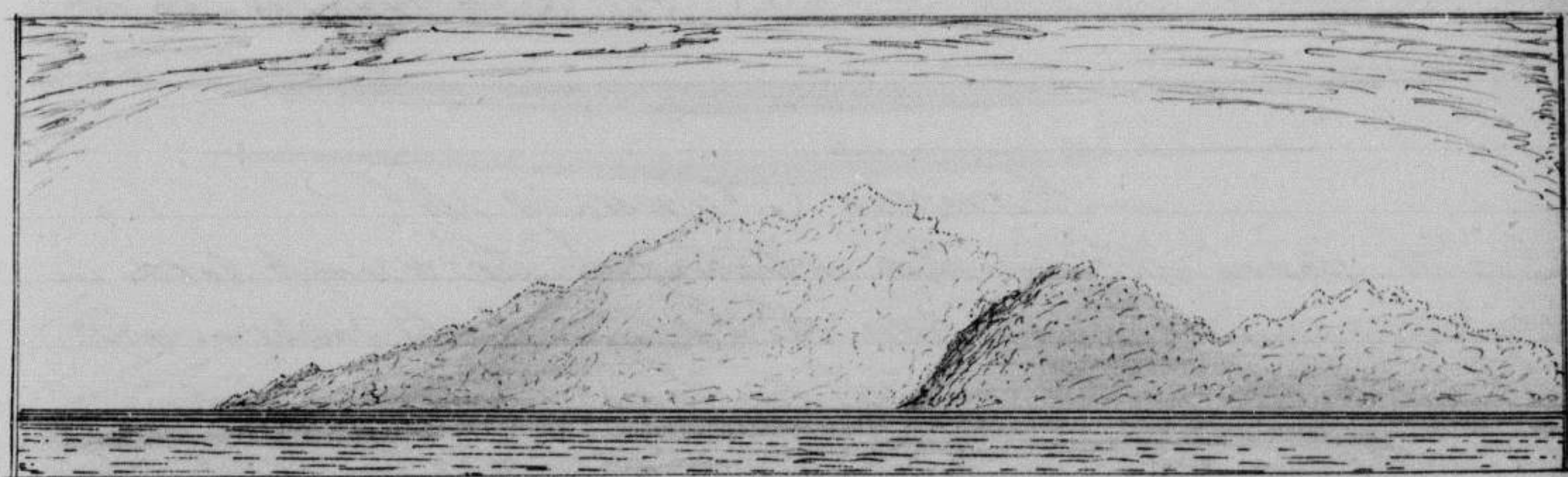
