

Ship Lion Cruising on New Zealand in 1844

Saturday January 20th

Time from the 8 on the wind to the south at 4 pm
Shook the Elizabeth of Salem 36 mo 1300 lb midair
and later the same Lat 32.10 Long 177.15.30

Sunday January 21st

Time from the East on the wind to the south at 4 pm
Shook the L C Richmond of New Bedford 32 mo
1950 lb midair and later the same
Lat 32.37 Long 177.01.15

Monday January 22nd

Time from the 8 on the wind to the south nothing in
sight midair and later the same Lat 32.08 Long 176.27.30

Tuesday January 23rd

Time from the 8 on the wind to the south midair
and later the same Lat 32.27 Long 176.27.30

Wednesday January 24th

Time from the 8 on the wind to the 8 nothing in sight
midair and later the same Lat 32.38 Long 176.32.30

Thursday January 25th

Time from the 8 steering East nothing in sight
midair and later the same steering East
Lat 32.18 Long 176.10.30

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Friday January 26th

Time from the 8 steering East at 4 pm 2 sperm whales lowered
but did not fasten midair and later strong at 8 and 9 sperm
whales lowered did not fasten the whales going quick



Saturday January 27th

Strong from the East at 2 pm 2 sperm whales lowered
fastened and the whale took the line fastened again and
hooked the whale took him along side and began to cut
midair left of cutting the whale sunk heavy later strong
at 12 and finished cutting Lat 30.16 Long 176.42.30

Sunday January 28th

Strong from the East on the wind to the 8 employed in
baying midair and more moderate Lat 30.16 Long 176.42.15

Monday January 29th

Time from the 8 on the wind to the 8 employed in baying
midair and later light Lat 30.46 Long 176.39.30

Tuesday January 30th

Light employed in baying midair and later the same
Lat 30.53 Long 176.33.15

Wednesday January 31st

Light from the 8 nothing in sight steering 8 employed
in driving the oil midair and later the same employed
in steering Lat 30.40 Long 175.31.15
