Sunday 27 commences with light N.E. winds
course S.W. & S. broke out after hole for
Bees. Molasses Beans. Rice Cod Bisk.
A.M. fine N.E. winds Studdings set.
10 thunder and rain double reefed. 12
made all sail.

Monday 28 commences with light N.W. winds all
sail set. 2 P.M. wind hauled & double reefed.
steering by to C.N.E. A.M. light winds from N.

March

Tuesday 29 commences with fine breezes from
the N. course S. 4 P.M. bent the topmast
Son 63.25. stud and set it. Studs aloft and aloft.
middle and latter strong N.W. winds.

Wednesday 2. with strong S.W. winds steering by
Sat 49.47 to the S.E. double reefed. A.M. light
Son 63.47. winds from N. course S. by W. 6 A.M.
broke out water from Tank.

Thursday 3rd commences with fine N. winds
Sat 51.71 course S.S.E. Studds aloft and aloft.
Son 63.50 A.M. fine breezes from N.W. all sail set
10 double reefed

Friday 4 commences with strong winds from
Sat 54.09 S.W. bying to N.W. & Foresail 6 reefed N.W.
Son 63.15 furlled Jib. 11 wind hauled N. made
sail. A.M. fine breezes all sail set.

Saturday 5 commences with strong N.W. winds
all sail set course S.S.E. 6 P.M. wind
Son 60.25 hauled to W. 10 P.M. double reefed Jib & No.
12 Made sail. saw a large clipper standing
to S.E.

Sunday 6th commences with strong N.W. winds
57.36 1 P.M. shortened sail. 4 blew a gale. bying
63.25 to under storm sails. 5 reefed foresail and
set it. 7 set fore & (Miz tops). 8 A.M. made
sail. 8 double reefed. 10 rains like

Monday 7 commences with fine northerly
winds course W.S.W. heavy head sea.
65.20 2 P.M. set No. 3 & 3 took it in and double
reefed. reefed mainsail. 4 strong. bying
to under close reefed No. 3 & 8 set Foresail
9 wore ship. 12 set Mainsail. 6 made sail.

Tuesday 8 commences with fine N.W. winds
57.48 and rainy weather. 5 P.M. double reefed.
66.18 10 wind hauled aft. course W.S.W.
double reefed furlled Jib & mainsail.
Barometer stands 28.2.

Wednesday 9. commences with fine breezes
from W. heading by to the S. under. doi
69.40 reef. Jib & Mainsail. 3 P.M. wind hauled
C.S.E. course W. by S. furlled Jib & Mainsail
& Miz Top sail. Thermometer 41. the lowest.
11 moderated 12 made sail. light variable winds
Pacific Ocean.

Thursday 10. commences with light variable
57.48 winds course W. by S. Squally & rainy.
68.30 5 A.M. breezes from S.S.W. 6. took in lights.

Friday 11 Fine breezes from S.S.W. reefed
57.75 Topsails. 3 signaled Ship Tiger of
70.20 Stonington Steaming N.E. 5 A.M. moderated
made all sail.
