Saturday 26 commences with fine breeze and
41.18 pleasant weather from N. N. W. steering
79.21 to S. put the waist and two boats
on the cranes. middle calm. lat light west

The chat tells his wife news. is but newly married

Sunday 27 commences with light winds and
39.30 pleasant weather from W. steering by to
78.49 N. employed in ships duty. middle
and latter same. heading by to N. N. E.

Men get wealth and women spend it.

Monday 28 commences as above. nothing remarkable
38.58 1 A.M. broke out flour between decks.

77.47 11 took in light sails. So ends 8

When all men say you are an ass. it is time enough to say.

Tuesday 29 commences with fresh breeze from
37.50 N. N. W. steering by to N. E. 2 P.M. double
75.45 reefed. 5 wore ship. heading to W. passed
mainsail. 7 took in jib and fore & main
topsails. thick rainy weather. 1 A.M. set
them. and mainsail. 5, made sail. 9 double
reefed. wind hauled W. wore ship to N.

A woman and a cherry were painted for their own harm. guess not. W.

Wednesday 30 commences with fresh breeze from W
under double reef. 4 P.M. hauled aft. made
sail. 12 hauled S. set studds aloft and aloft.
heavy rains. 7 A.M. hoke out after hole for
Beef and Molasses. So ends 8c.

Get a name for rising early and you may lie in bed all day.

Thursday 31 commences with fine S winds and pleasant
35.27 weather. Course N. W. by W. 4 P.M. went up fore
77.26 mast and set it. 3 A.M. raised the island
of Juan Fernandez bearing N. W. huffed to
hauled aback daylight spoke ship Eric of
Blackm. Their Wagon 27 was out 3300. had a gam.
11 boat went aboard. Calm. calm.

Remarks on board Ship Daniel Wood 1853.
April.

Friday 1 commences with calm and pleasant weath
33.41 er. off Juan. There are about 150 persons
78.53 on this Island mostly Spaniards. 809
Lat. whom are convicts from the Main. They
and have a governor over them. 4 P.M. a boat from
San the Vigilant. Dublin of New Bedford. came
9 on board. 9 was out 200 sp. had a gam. lay
Juan. aback till 8. holed full and stood along
East. pt N. N. W. wind W. light winds all night. the
partner. the Vig. about 6 mile astern. 5 A.M.
hoke fore & main hatches for hoops. stowed
them in the run. So ends 8c.

Either accomplish. or never attempt.

Saturday 2 commences with light W winds &
32.20 pleasant weather. steering by to N. N. W. sent
79.13 down main stay and shortened each spoke
set it up. 4. worked hauled S. W. course N. W.
set studding sail. The Vig. hauled down on
weather quarter. Light winds. 7 A.M. hoke out
after hole for Butter. Beans. Cod Fish.

Will not to misfortune but surmount them.

Sunday 3 calm and pleasant weather. hoke
32.20 out main hatches between decks coopered that
casks. nothing in sight. middle and latter
light variable W winds. steering by on diff tacks.

Trifle not with life. But fear not death.

Monday 4 commences with fine N N W winds. steering
32.44 by to N. E. nothing in sight. A.M. daylight. raised
79.14 sperm whales 78 In the lee
beam. lowered and the
Bow Boat got one.

Tuesday 5 commences as above. got him alongside
and begun to cut. finished cutting body.
A.M. daylight took in junk and haled
case. begun to bil. holed forward.
