

Ship Daniel Wood on her passage to Sandwich Island

May

Tuesday 10. Commences with fine N.E. Trades. course N. N. W.
16. 54 M. 144. 58 W. employed setting up shooks. A.M. 5. strong
beers to in Rigals & Studdings. Shooks. Shooks.

Wednesday 11 Fine N.E. Trades. set Rigs & Studds. A.M. 4 took
14. 15 = 148. 20 in Rigs & Studds. 6 perled light sails. 10 set N.E. 7. 5.

Thursday 12 Fine N.E. Trades. made sail. N. & S. course N.
19. 55 = 152. rose King Stoppers and Shank Painters. A.P.M.
took in Studding's and Rigals. A.M. thick. raining.

Friday 13. Fine N.E. Trades course N. S. W. 2 P.M. saw a sail.
20. 14. 154. 10. 3 made the Island of Owhree. stood in for
Lying Byron's Bay. it being thick stood off again to N.
at 42 wore to S.E. daylight kept off and run into
the Bay. Got anchors off. &c. at 10 A.M. came to an
in anchor in Kilo. cleared up. washed off &c &c &c.

Sat 14. Got off a small raft of water. filling cask &c &c.

Sun 15. A.M. got off a raft and stowed it down. got 50 lbs
Beef. 10 Rps Bread. &c &c &c. Ship Richard Mitchell.

Sun 15. Cyprus 4 1/2 mos out 90 lbs up. came in this afternoon
Weather is raining and nasty. A.M. Liberty. 4 men
ran away but are retaken and calabossed.

Mon 16 got ashore flour, goods &c &c and boat crew ashore
on liberty. Got off a raft of water. stowed down lower hole.

Tues 17 one watch ashore on liberty. Got off a small raft of
Wednesday water. Got ashore 2 pipes head 3 cask Flour. 1 watch
ashore. Ship Doctor of Noetic came in this afternoon
from San Francisco. found a cruise whaling. 20 ends.

Thurs 18. 1 watch ashore on liberty. got aboard 35 lbs Sweet and
20 of Irish Potatoes. &c &c &c. Baggage &c &c &c

Friday 20 Took four men from calaboose. who came on board
and went to duty. passengers. savages &c &c &c &c &c.
1 A.M. got under weigh but the wind dying anchored
again. 9 perled anchor and stood out to sea.

Remarks on board Ship Daniel Wood 1853.

May

Sat 21 commences with fine N.E. Trades and pleasant
weather. beating out of Byron's Bay. daylight saw
Morue.

Sun 22. As above passed the Islands of Raani and
Morotoi. (Malachi) A.M. saw Wahu. daylight
kept off an run down to 1 1/4 miles reef. discharged
passengers. Savages. Laying off an on.

Monday 23. Strong N.E. Trades double uped Fore and single
reefed Main and Mizen. Laying off and on.
A.M. ditto got off 20 lbs potatoes.

Tuesday 24. Fine N.E. Trades 1 P.M. boat came off. Shipped
3 Hanachas. made sail. course N. by S. Studdings.
passed the Isles of Altai. Once more Takora.

Wednesday 25. Light N.E. Trades. course N. cleaning boats
for painting. Takora bears N by N. dis. 20 miles.
A.M. calm. and light variable. washing ship outside.

Thurs 26 Calm. Calm. Calm. painting boats &c &c &c.
21. 36 & 161. 34 W. A.M. ditto painting ship outside N. & S.

Friday 27 Calm as usual. painting ship. nothing in sight
course N. by N. A.M. painting ship inside. Rigals & Studds

Satur 28 commences with light N.E. winds. course N. by N.
22. 05 painting ship inside. A.M. set up the Fore rigging
163. 31 painting ship &c &c. S. & S

Sunday 29 commences with light N.E. Trades course N. by N.
A.M. ditto. employed ships duty. N. & Studds

Monday 30 Commences with fine E. N.E. winds pleasant weather
23. 28 course N. employed sorting Potatoes &c &c.
