Thursday 27 Fine Breeze from N.W. course E. of N
45.57 Thick. Rain weather.
172.00 hoke out for Beef. Bread. Oil.

Friday 28 Fine breeze from N steering by to E. all sail.
44.50 11 P.M. took in light sails. 3 double reefed. handed
163.55 Jib and mainsail. Fore Topsail. 8 AM put in Mizzen
and Foresail. close reefed the M. Topsail.

Saturday 29. Lying to under Storm sails. store the Bally

Sunday 30 ditto ditto.

Monday 31 do. 4 set Fore Topsail. wind N.W. 3 set
Jib and mainsail. daylight. all sail. Foggy.

40.25 all sail set. daylight set Studds. sent up M. Royal.

39.56 winds. with Rain. A.M. employed breaking out

158.45 ing off after hoke. A.M. light from N.E. by to S.E.
washing Bone

Friday 4 Commences with light E. winds. steering by
36.94 to S. Commenced a sentimental lying off
A.M. do. employed washing ship

Saturday 5 Fine breeze and pleasant weather come
34.15 steering by the wind to S. washing ship
158.32 A.M. light from S. by to E. heavy swell from E.

Sunday 6 Fresh from S. under double reefs. middle
raining. A.M. wind N.W. course S. by E. sail on
Starboard beam.

Monday 7. Fine breeze from N.W. course S. by E. E.
31.46 sail in sight. middle and latter same.

Tuesday 8 As above. sent down spanker gaff.
29.35 scraped it and sent up again.

Wednesday 9. Fine breeze from E. course E. of E. employ
27.00 bed ships duty. sail in sight on weather bow.
154.19 A.M. hoke out Bone and stowed it back again

Thursday 10 Fine breeze from E. of S. all sail set.
23.59 stowing Bone der. sail off lee beam. A.M. do
155.40 washing Bone. nothing in sight.

Friday 11. As above. employed ships duty. A.M. raised
21.46 the land. kept off for Lyons Bay.

Sat 12 As ran to the Harbor & came to an anchor in
Toito.
