

Remarks on board ship Daniel Wood 1853.
November 12.

Came to anchor in Hilo. The Pacific, Allen
Lying Ontario, Leek, Rambler, Miller, Thomas Age, Mary
at are here at anchor the Hibernia, Jeffery, The Columbia
anchor Cask, and the Callao, Baker arrived while we were
in here. We have had various kinds of weather and
Hilo, part of the time a very heavy swell has been
to rolling in. Had six days liberty each watch.
Decem. shipped about 500 lbs of Oil and 7000 lbs of Bone
the 8th on board the ship Ontario of Sag Harbor, got off
Pkg. 250 lbs water, stowed our cask and filled them
Coat, with salt water, painted ship, did some trading
Cock, got off 40 lbs of Potatoes, discharged 2 Kanakas
then shipped 5 more and are now ready for sea.

December. discharged James Hammond.

Thursday 8. Got under weigh with the Columbia and
Callao. The wind being light the Callao, and our
came back and anchored, the Columbia got out
that day.

Friday 9. Got under weigh and came to an anchor
again 2 or 3 times, but finally got clear. Fine Trades
course S.W. 3 A.M. hauled aback and laid till
daylight, kept off and run down to Maui. The

Satur 10. Captain went ashore, shipped his men, got 10 lbs
Fresh Potatoes, 6 A.M. came aboard, and stood along
daylight raised the Island of Oahu. 9 A.M. luffed to
and the captain went ashore. I went in and
got the letters, and bought them off.

Sunday 11
Laying off and on with 5 ships, split the fit
sent it in and bent a new one.

Monday 12. Laying off and on as above under short sail.

Tuesday 13. do do. do. do. 6 P.M. the captain came
onboard. Made sail course S.E. & S. A.M. Fine Trades.

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Wednesday 14. Commences with Fine Trades, steering
by to S.S.E. spoke the Pacific, had a garn. A.M.
do. mending Waist Boat &c. &c. &c. -

Thursday 15. Fresh from E.M.C. took in light sails,
reefed the 3rd Tops. Rain squalls, the P. in sight.

Friday 16. Fine Trades, steering by to S.S.E. the P. on the
14.30 lee quarter 5 miles off. A.M. Fresh, took in light
sails, double reefed.

Saturday 17. As above under double reefs, 5 spoke the
11.40 Pacific. Employed fitting the cutting Blocks &c. &c.
A.M. do. under single reefed Tops. Rainy.

Sunday 18. Fresh Trades, under double reefs, steering by
8.57 the wind to S.S.E. the P. on lee quarter.
A.M. do. do. Rainy. Rainy. Run off for the P.

Monday 19. Fresh Trades, under double reefs, fueled
7.07 fit 8 Mainsail. Spoke the Pacific, had a garn.
A.M. ditto steering by to S.S. mending K. Boat.

Tuesday 20. Fresh from E.M.C. under double reefs
5.20 the P. in sight. A.M. do. Painting Boats &c. &c.

Wednesday 21. Fine from E.M.C. all sail set, steering by.
2.57. 157.17 A.M. kept off S.S.W. employed ships duty.
One year from home.

Thursday 22. As above, course w.s.w. Turned in the
main rigging, set up head stays &c. &c. &c.
Spoke the P. had a garn.

Friday 23. As above, course w.s.w. employed in the
Rigging. A.M. do do do.
