

Remarks on Board Ship Daniel Wood in —
Sunday June 11

Light winds Boiling. 6 fresh under
double reef 10 under Main & Fore sail.
A.M. finished Boiling 70 bls. commenced stowing on
starboard side Main hatches forward. 12 finished
stowing 50 bls.

Monday 12

Stowing down on the starboard side of
hatches. aft. finished stowing 50 bls. no whales
but a plenty of ships. A.M. chasing one whale. all we
saw. stowed 50 bls on larboard side of Main hatches
and fore hold.

Tuesday 13

Standing along the ice. 6 ruined whales
lowered for them. 7 came on board. under short
sail. A.M. 7 lowered and the Larboard boat got
one. got him alongside and began to cut.

Wednesday 14

Cutting. 4 P.M. finished and lowered 3 Boats.
but did not get near. Spoke the Concordia 3 whales.
cabin. 7 made a fire and began to boil. calm light
weather. 60 ships in sight.

Thursday 15

Light S.E. Boiling 2 lowered 3 Boats for
whales. 4 came on board. A.M. fresh from S.E. under
double reef. finished boiling 150 bls oil.

Friday 16

Light variable winds among ice. cutting
up our Bone into single slabs. 6 P.M. lowered and
the Waist Boat got one. got him alongside and
commenced stowing down on larboard side of Fore
Hold. aft. 4 A.M. finished stowing 100 bls. 6 began to cut.
Spoke the Mercury 7 whales. Goodwill. 6 bls. 5 whales.

Saturday June 17

finished cutting. started the works.
found a pot broke A.M. Boiling. stowed 50 bls oil in
fore hold. both sides. 13 cooled down.

Sunday 18

Took out the old pot and set a new one.
5 P.M. started the works. 39 ships in sight & boiling
A.M. 34 ships. 10 Boiling. Fine breeze under 2 reefs.

Monday 19

Fine clear weather. boiling. spoke the Diabla
3 whales. the young Phoenix 3. A.M. light winds
the ice in sight. spoke the ^{Anna} Thornmont. Young
6 whales. 24 ships in sight & cutting. Boiling.

Tuesday 20

Fresh breeze. on stiff tack. took in Fore
Topsail and Jib. Boiling. A.M. fresh from S. finished
ed boiling 150 bls oil. commenced stowing on star-
board side Main hatches. aft. spoke the Cooper. Fisher
who had run into a cake of ice ~~the day~~ before, and
and stove a hole in her bows. 3 feet below the
water line. had repaired it temporarily.

Wednesday 21

Fresh from S. Stowing down. 6 finished
stowing 100 bls. started 40 bls fresh water into
pipes. A.M. foggy. stowing water between decks. scraping
Bone saw a ship pick up a dead whale.

Thursday 22

Foggy. scraping Bone. spoke the Walter
Scott. Edgerton. Collins. 1 whale A.M. foggy.
scraping Bone, and stowing it on the House

Friday 23

Alternately foggy and clear. Jonas Island
in sight. 4 finished our Bone spoke the Almira.
finished. 10 whales. 8 shortened sail. Boats crew watched.
A.M. clear. 16 ships in sight. 3 cutting. running along
the ice to N.W.
