

Ship Daniel Wood in Whale Bay. 184.

July Saturday 8th Sunday 9th

Whaling Ice and Land in sight
10 ships 2 Boiling, 8 anchored with the Tidge and
small chain in 20 Fathoms. A.M. foggy. large bodies
of Ice drifting by us. in each tide.

Monday 10

Laying at anchor in a thick fog. At 9 A.M.
got under weigh and stood to the S. foggy.

Tuesday 11

Fine breeze, standing along to S. Spoke the
Caroline. Gifford. 4 whales. a boat from Hatteras.
and a boat with a whale, belonging to the
Republic. 7 whales. Landed for whales, but did not
strike. came aboard and run off to S. at 6 P.M. it
coming in thick, anchored in 12 Fathoms. A.M. at 4
3 Boats left the ship and went into the Land.
Foggy. 11 got under weigh and stood to S. run the shore
down to W.

Wednesday 12

Fine B. wind. 12 ships in sight. 4 Boiling
saw the Fanny with 2 dead whales and the Sea with
one. 6 P.M. came to anchor in a Bay in 5 Fathoms.
10 the Boats came on board. A.M. Rainy. Rainy Whaling
16 ships at anchor and 20 more around the sand
Point.

Thursday 13

Rainy. the Surboard Boat caught a calf.
cut him in. The Bow Boat ashore on the flats all
night. A.M. whaling. The whale made 25 Hls.

Friday 14

Whaling. the Waist Boat got one. He made 15 Hls.
Laying here until Wednesday 18th Bay Whaling.

Thursday 15

Fine weather. 8 o'clock to an anchor in 10 Fath.
rainy nasty weather. Laying on our oars

Ship Daniel Wood Bay Whaling. 184. at anchor.

Friday July 13th 14

Whaling. A.M. 2 Boats round the S.
Point. and 2 in the Bay.

Saturday 15

The Waist Boat got a whale, anchored
him, at 10 got aboard. A.M. 3 Boats whaling
round the Point. The B. Boat aboard. Boiling. Got
under weigh, and run out about 8 miles and
anchored again.

Sunday 16

3 Boats hooked on to the whale and
towed him with the tide about 2 miles from
the S. point. The ship got under weigh again
and came down to us and anchored again. A.M.
the S. Boat stoped aboard and cut him in.

Monday 17

4 Boats whaling. A.M. S. Boat aboard
Boiling. 3 Boats whaling

Tuesday 18

Whaling & the Boats came on board, the
Antelope got a whale. A.M. 4 Boats whaling

Wednesday 19

Whaling 2 Boats stoped ashore, the other
2 came on board. A.M. got under weigh and stood
out towards the mouth of the Bay. 10 took up the S.
and B. Boats.

Thursday 20

At 6 P.M. came to an anchor in 12
Fathoms water. A.M. Rainy no whales. all aboard.

Friday 21st

do. do. strong from S.E. 2 anchors down. A.M.
S. got under weigh. but the wind dying came to an
anchor again in 12 Fathoms.

Saturday 22

Calm. 3 Boats went in shore. saw nothing
S. A.M. got under weigh. 8 anchored again in 15 Fathoms.
calm. rainy weather.
