

Ship Daniel Wood in Ochotsk Sea 1154. Cruising.
Wednesday August 9

Light winds. no whale. 3 ships in sight. running along shore. spoke the South America Walker. 2200. A.M. Light winds and clear. course S.E.

Thursday 10

Light variable winds working to S.E. in company with the Mercury. lowered for House Diggers. A.M. do do Land in sight.

Friday 11

Light winds, working to N.E. A.M. do do

Saturday 12

Light S. winds. course S.E. Land in sight. A.M. Light to winds and thick weather by the wind on cliff tacks. Land. Land.

Sunday 13

Commences with light winds and thick weather. from E. by the wind on cliff tacks. A heavy swell from S.E. Land in sight. A.M. thick weather. Equally

Monday 14

Calm light weather. at 10 P.M. took the wind from S.W. course S.E. A.M. calm. drying bone and stow it in the Fore Hold. Land in sight

Tuesday 15

Light variable winds working to the S.E. drying bone and stowing it in Fore Hold. Land. A.M. fresh with rain squalls. latter part light weather. drying bone.

Wednesday 16

Lat 58.15 N. Lon 141.33 E.
Light winds, course E. Land in sight. A.M. fine from S.W. course S.E. Land.

Thursday 17

Fine from S.W. course S.E. A.M. fine S.W. by the wind to S.E. 3 sails in sight. 10. we are ahead of Fog Island. saw a muske digger.

Friday 18

Fine from ~~S.W.~~ course S.E. Bow Head Island bearing E. 20 miles dis. 4 fresh, double reefed. by the wind.

Ship Daniel Wood in the Gulf of Sanvik 1154.
Friday August 16

A.M. fine. lowered for whale. the Starboard Boat struck. got him alongside and began to cut.

Saturday 19

Cutting. 4 P.M. finished. cleared away the Head & S. Whaling 2 Boats. stopped on Fabius Island all night. started the work. A.M. the ship came in to Fabius Harbor and anchored. Whaling. The Russian Bark Agan. lying here.

Sunday 20

Whaling. Boiling. 2 Boats N.E. anchored out all night. A.M. Whaling.

Monday 21

Boiling 2 came on board. A.M. Land 13. Boats whaling. 2 Boats stowing down. checked off the Main Hatchets. The Dohys visited us. bringing Larders. milk Salmon. berries &c in plenty. From F. L. B. W. N.

Tuesday 22

NEW BEDFORD, MASS.

Stowing in after Hold. Lar' side. stowed 85 Hbl. A.M. Boats came back. stowing in after Hold. Bot under weigh and stood out into the Bay.

Wednesday 23

Stowing down. finished stowing 84 Hbl. Whaling. A.M. Calm. lowered and pulled in towards Bow Head Island

Thursday 24

Calm. a few whales in sight. spoke the Margaret Scott. Eldridge 200. 5 ships in sight. A.M. fine. cruising in the Bay. wrapping bone.

Friday 25

Whaling. spoke the M. G. Calm. A.M. do. whales but no wind.

Saturday 26

Chasing whales the Bow Boat struck and parted. What Luck. A.M. Light winds.
