

Ship Daniel Wood in Ochotsk Sea 1854.
Tuesday October 10

Fine breeze from N. course S.W.W.
4 light winds. middle squally. took in the light sails
A.M. strong squalls. with snow. double reefed. furl'd Main
Wednesday 11

Strong from N. furl'd jib. snow squalls. saw
Hills. middle furl'd Foresail. A.M. strong by the wind
heaving from S.W. to S. took in Fore Topsail.
Thursday 12

Fresh from N. set J. Topsail Foresail and jib.
6 set mainsail. saw a Big stranding to S.E. A.M.
light winds and a heavy swell from S.
Lat 53.50 N. Lon 143.53 East.

Friday 13
Light breeze and pleasant from N. course S.W.S.
all sail set. middle rainy. A.M. fresh from N. course
S.W. S. 8 kept off S. 9 raised Cape Elisabeth bearing N.
dis 20 miles. sent down the Main sail. mended it and
sent it again. hauled our wind heading N.
Lat 54.40 N. Lon 143.36 E.

Saturday 14
Fine S. breeze. 2 kept off S. and run the shore
down. land 10 miles dis. a strong current setting off
shore. 4 P.M. hauled up S.E. 7 took a breeze from S.
by the wind to E. A.M. wind at N.W. course S.E. E.
Lat 53.45 N. Lon 147.00 E.

Sunday 15.
Commenced with fine breeze from N.W. course
S.E.E. Middle calms A.M. fine breeze from S.E. by the wind
to E. A.M. saw Fin Backs. Lat 53.03 N.

Monday 16
Fine breeze and cloudy weather from S.E. by the
wind to E. A.M. under whole Topsails and courses.
4 P.M. heading her course S.E.E. all sail set. 10 it
bearing on took in the light sails. Took the wind strong
and sudden from N.W. all hands to shorten sail.
double reefed fore & main and furl'd Main tops and Foresail.

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Monday October 16

A.M. Blow a gale. running before
it to S.E.E. Hail squalls. saw 3 Right Whales.
Tuesday 17

It blowing on the sea rising. close reefed the M.
and furl'd Fore Tops and Foresail. and hoey to.
3 kept off again. set Foresail. 2 reefed Main Tops.
7 luffed to. again. close reefed and furl'd Foresail.
Hail squalls. A.M. kept off again. made sail. sent
down cutting tackle. stowed them on Fly Works.
Lat 50.43 N. Lon 152.50 E.

Wednesday 18
Fine S.W. winds all sail set. 7 P.M. double
reefed and luffed to the wind. daylight made all sail
and came through the Ochotsk Passage. stowed the
Bone down Main hatches from house.

Lat 49.41 N. Lon 154.31 East.
Left the Ochotsk Sea.

Thursday 19 Haul. Wakes. Haul.
Fine S.W. breeze. course E by S. all sail set.
Bent J. Top and M. T. G. Studding sails and set them.
Friday 20

Fine S. breeze. course E by S. all sail set.
A.M. by the wind to E. making 2 yarn spun yarn.

Saturday 21
Fine from S. by to E. Took in light sails and
double reefed & furl'd jib & Mainsail. A.M. Made
all sail. Light winds and a heavy swell from S.
Lat 49.20 N. Lon 157.06 E.

Sunday 22
Light variable winds and a heavy swell
from S. employed making Bone spun yarn. A.M.
fine from S. by to E. a very heavy swell from S.
Lat 48.25 N. Lon 166.50 E.

Monday 23
Fine breeze from S. by to E. S.E. Middle rainy.
A.M. do do
