Tuesday, October 24th

Took a fine breeze from N. which
blows on in squalls. course E by S. made all sail. strong breeze
with squalls double reefed S. & Main Top. A.M. 10.00
fueled the No. 1.3.

Lat 46.00 N. Lon 175.37 W

Wednesday 25

Fresh from N. course E by S. set the No. 1.3.
A.M. moderate, made all sail, set the Studs.
Crossed the Meridian.

Wednesday 25

Fresh from S. took in light sails and
double reefed. Rain Rain. 6 light winds and a heavy
swell from Westward. A.M. Took a fine breeze from
N. course E by S. made all sail, Studs.

Lat 43.50 N. Lon 177.32 West.

Thursday 26

Fine breeze from N. course E by S. all sail.
middle and latter do. do. saw a Fin Back.

Lat 42.40 N. Lon 175.39 West.

Friday 27

Light winds and pleasant from N. course E.
making spun yarn. A.M. wind S. washing ship
and over head Boats. Sail in sight.

Saturday 28

Fresh from S. course E. Took in light
sails and double reefed. & fueled 1st & Main sail.
A.M. 1 The wind hauled to N. whole main Top &
No. 1.3. the water covered with Japan Cruisers.

Lat 41.18 N. Lon 166.29 West.

Sunday 29

Commenced with strong breeze, and squally
weather from N. under Main Top. 2 reefed Fore J.
& Foresail. course E. A.M. moderate made sail.

Monday 30

Fine N. breeze course E by S. Rain squalls.
A.M. do washing ship. Lat 37.58 N. Lon 161.58 West.

Fine N. breeze course E by S. washing
ship. A.M. do Lat 36.00 Lon 160.10 West.

Wednesday November 1st

Fine breeze from N. course S.E. E.
washing ship outside. Sail on the weather bow. A.M.
wind S by E to E.S.E. 10 the wind hauled to N.W. course
S.E. all sail. Lat 34.06 Lon 157.48 W.

Thursday 2

Fine from S.S.W. course S.E. washing ship.
Waiting Fore Rigging. A.M. do. at work in Rigging.
Lat 31.55

Friday 3

Fine from S by E to E.S.E. all sail set. A.M. do. do.
washing Bone, and at work in Rigging. Light sails fished.
Lat 30.12 N. Lon 153.44 West.

Saturday 4

Fresh breeze from S.E. E. by the wind to E.
& set the No. 1.3. employed in the Rigging and
washing Bone. A.M. 1 Tacked to S.W. Light winds.
employed washing Bone & the scraping mast & S. Boom.
Lat 29.25 N. Lon 154.03 W.

Sunday 5

Light from S.S.W. with rain. Washing Bone &.
A.M. do fine pleasant weather. Fin Backs. Sail in harbor.
Lat 28.30 N. 155.24 W.

Monday 6

Fine pleasant weather, by the wind to N.
& P.M. Tacked to E. 9 took the wind from E. by S.
S.S.E. A.M. do. do. drying Bone and stowing it down M. hatch.
Lat 28.04 Lon 155.05 W.

Tuesday 7

Light breeze and pleasant weather from
E.S.E. by S.E. Washing Bone Painting gang way
ladder & S. E. A.M. do. Washing Bone. Painted Port Boat.
Rain squalls Lat 26.20 N. Lon 154.46 West.

Trades
Bent Main Royal and sent it aloft.
