

Ship Daniel Wood on her passage to the S. Is. 115th
Wednesday November 8.

Commenced with light E. & E.
winds and pleasant weather. Washing Bone &c. A.M.
do. washing Bone. course S. by E. 1/2 E. Painting
Lat 24.15 N. Lon 154.45 West.

Thursday 9. Fine & windy and pleasant weather. course
S. by E. all sail set. Washing and drying Bone. stowing
it down Main Hatch. 6 P.M. had a heavy rain squall
which last half an hour. A.M. fine breeze from E. course
course S. by E. & E. Various employed.
Lat 24.22 N. Lon 154.29 West

Friday 10. Commenced with fine E winds and clear
weather. course S. E. & E. Various employed. 6 P.M. light
from S.E. by to S.W. Calm and a perfect water storm
by squalls till 11 P.M. A.M. fine breeze from E. light sails
furled. Daylight made all sail and kept off S.W. I raised
the Sails of Owhyee, ahead.

Saturday 11. Fine E winds. 12 raised Blonde Point. 3 the
wind backed us off so we wore ship took a Pilot.
wore ship again, and stood up to N.W. 5 kept off
and run into the anchorage, where we came to a 6 1/2 P.M.
The Market is in Lat 19.43.51 N.
Lon 155.03.00 W.
Variation E. 50 East.

A.M. got 17 Pipes ashore out of the way. washed hands &c.
Rising. Sat P.M. Various employed.

Sunday 12 Starboard Watch. on Liberty. Pleasant.
Monday 13 Starboard " do do Bundling Bone.
finished 55 Bundles. stowed it down Main Hatch.
Tuesday 14 Starboard " Bundled 67 Bundles.
Wednesday 15 Starboard " Washing Bone Bundled 12.
Thursday 16 Starboard " Bundled 12 and shipped 146
Bundles on board Wiberuia &
Friday 17 Starboard " Painting &c. &c. &c.

Lat 19th Dec 19th On Liberty -
Monday 20

Commenced discharging our oil, and
shipping it on board the S. Copia, using a scow.
Saturday Dec 2nd shipped 1373 lbs (145 lb) which
took all. leaving us clean. having stowed back our
cask as fast as returned continued stowing off
filling with salt water. Got off 300 lbs of water.
and one provision before landed. viz 50 lbs meat,
10 Pipes Bread, 7 cask Flour, 12 lbs Sweet Potatoes.
Painted spars. Ship. 5 days more liberty. the Star
Watch having the last day. discharged 6 Kanakas
shipped 6 more. took passengers on board and are
now ready for sea. Dec 15th

Wednesday 15th. At 3 A.M. got under weigh with a
fine N. breeze off land. and stood out of the reef.
Running along the land. Fine S.E. winds
Thursday 14. Light winds and pleasant. A.M. slack
Friday 15.

Light winds. At 5 P.M. came to an anchor
off Kawakae. Landed passengers. got off 30 lbs Potatoes.
4 lbs Onions. at 2 A.M. got under weigh and
stood over toward Maui.

Saturday 16. Strong from S.W. took in sail. 6 P.M.
under close reef. A.M. no wind. lying there. close reef.

Sunday 17 In the Goldenrod. Rain. Rain. Rain.
Monday 18

Fine S.E. breeze. by the wind on stiff tacks
it being Sunday. did not run in. A.M. Calm light
weather.

Tuesday 19. Light variable winds. working into the
passage. A.M. went ashore at Lakaia. saw C. B.
Wednesday 20. 5 P.M. came on board. Calm. Calm.
Friday 22. Off Oahu. The Capt ashore off and on
until Tuesday 26th P.M. We got 15 lbs meat and a
cask of 1 lbs beef. 4 Natives jumped overboard, last Thursday.
