Wednesday 13.

Calm, Foggy. A.M. do. do. See.

Foggy. Calm. A.M. do. do.

Friday 15

Sight Foggy weather spoke Minerva
bound to N.E. A.M. clear 6 ships in sight. See
A.M. fine clear weather.

Saturday 16

Sight variable winds. Gamming
with Newburgport. Mary Gardner and
Speedwell, who is boiling a Hump Back. See.
A.M. fine, light weather.

Sunday 17

Calm. Gamming with Polar Star
Corington and Hoogly A.M. fine from S.W. course
N.E. 10 passed to S of Jonas Is. Spoke Midas
running along the ice.

Monday 18

Fresh from S.W. course N.E. A.M. no ice
in sight. Saw Land to N. 3 ships in sight.

Tuesday 19

Strong from S.W. 3 took a squall which
canted the wind to N. 5 heaved to the wind
under 3 Keefed Mr. Lohs middle moderate.
set Fore and Main Taps. A.M. set Jib and M.
Jog Is. and Bow Head Is. in sight.

Wednesday 20

Fine from N.W. by to N.E. A.M. light
variable winds. 4 ships in sight.

In The Gulf of Davis

Ship D. Wood in the Gulf of Davis, whaling 1855.
Thursday 21 June.

Commenced with light winds and
and clear weather from N. 5 spoke the Haverly
Met. 3 whales. A.M. clear calm weather. 7. 4 Boats
into the Land saw nothing. 3 ships in sight.

Friday 22.

Fine breeze from N.W. by on cliff
tacks. 4 ships in sight. A.M. calm.

Saturday 23

Sight S winds spoke the Midas.
Saw the Florida Boiling under Jeffers Pt.
I run into Jeanette Bay with the Midas
and came to an anchor in 27 Fathoms
A.M. Rainy 4 Boats whaling.

Sunday 24

Rainy. Saw 3 ships go into Fabius
Harbor. 1 Boiling. Whaling Whaling
2nd The L.B. got a 20 bl whale and the N.B.
30. A.M. got under weigh and towed her out
30th Having ship with calm light 5 came to
an anchor off Fabius Is. A.M. daylight com-
menced towing our 2 whales. Calm. 3rd
towing. 7 P.M. got them along side. A.M. 2 Boats
whaling.

Monday July 2nd

Boiling. A.M. do. 3rd finished
50 bls. A.M. 2 got under weigh. and stood out
into the Bay.

Tuesday 4.

Harry Hanaka died. A.M. run back
into Fabius Harbor, and anchored. 10 took
him ashore on the Island, and buried him.
