

Ship D. Wood in the Gulf of Tarrick 1855.
Thursday July 5

3 Boats whaling. S.B. aboard
stowed 50 bbls. bar side. No fish. Hatches aft.
Raining. A.M. down to Doboy Town after a load
of fish. 3 Boats went home.
Friday 6

A.M. got 700 Salmon and started
out of the River but it blowing heavy from
E. & anchored them out side the passage
and went in to the river again where we
were obliged to stop 4 days it blowing a Gale.
Tuesday 10. A.M. came aboard. A.M. got the Boat
but lost our fish. Got 200 fresh fish. Got under
weigh and stood out into the Bay —
Wednesday 11

Light winds and rainy weather.
Spoke the Cambria, who had struck a large
whale to day and lost a line. A.M. calm
5 ships in sight.

Thursday 12

Light winds. lowered for a whale
2 came on board. saw him no more. A.M.
calm. foggy. saw him no more. Scraping Bone.

Friday 13

Thick fog and calm weather 3 ships
near us. A.M. heat some water and washed
some oily Bone.

Saturday 14

Clear fine breeze from W.S.W. by on
diff tacks, washing Bone. 4 ships in sight 1
cutting. 6 lowered for kipsacks. 7 came on board.
took in light sails. A.M. calm. saw 4 ships take
whales, but it being calm could not get up to
the whales, they being in a body. and the ships
anchored among them from 15 to 30 W whales.

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Sunday July 15.

Saw a few straggling whales. A.M.
fresh from S.S.E. foggy. Rain. Doubt's reefed.
Monday 16

Calm rainy weather. 4 ships in sight
2 Boiling. A.M. Calm, Calm.

Tuesday 17

Calm. Spoke the Ohio. 700. A.M. Calm

Wednesday 18

Light winds. 4 Boats whaling. Saw
several whales, wild as hares. 4 ships in sight

Thursday 19

Whaling. light calm weather. 10 an-
chored in 13 Fathoms. A.M. 4 Boats whaling
calm. saw nothing.

Friday 20

Whaling. saw nothing. A.M. foggy. Whaling.

Saturday 21

Light winds. no whales. muscle diggers.
3 Got under weigh. A.M. fine from S.E. No whale

Sunday 22

Fresh from S.E. close reefed F.D.M. in
Tops. 2 Reefed Main. put in foresail. A.M. fine.
from E. 10 run into Fabius Warba and anchored

Monday 23

2 Boats whaling 2 for water. A.M. got
off a raft of 13 Peps.

Tuesday 24

Boats aboard. A.M. 3 Boats watering
Calm. no whales.

Wednesday 25

Got off a Raft of 15 Peps. 120 Wbl in
all. stowed it between decks. A.M. Got under
weigh.

Thursday 26

Rainy. stood to N. & towards Fog Isle. 2 ships in
sight. A.M. saw a Bow Head. lowered but saw
him no more. Spoke Cambria. Boiling.
