

Ship D. Wood in the Gulf of Tarrick 1855.
Friday July 27.

Calm. 4 ships in sight. Whaling
the W.B. struck, anchored him. 50 Hls.
Saturday 28.

A. Came to an anchor alongside of him
in 12 fathoms. 7 got under weigh again. A.M.
foggy. Boiling.

Sunday 29.
3. lowered and the L.B. got me.
5 anchored in 20 fathoms and cut him in
46 got under weigh again, and stood off shore
A.M. by the wind to S.E.

Monday 30
Ran into Fabius Harbor. the Cambria
followed in. Boiled them out and stowed down
130 Hls. Got 12 Hls of meat from Cambria.

Monday August 6.
Got under weigh and stood
down the Bay. 2 Boats whaling. the L.B. got a
35 Hls. calm. drifted up to him and cut him
in.

Tuesday 7
Rainy, light winds from N.W. by to S.W.
4 ships in sight. A.M. fine. 3 started the work
saw nothing spoke Florida.

Wednesday 8.
Boiling. finished 30 Hls. 4 ships in
sight. Calm. Gunning with Florida. A.M. Rainy
thick. Gunning with Pacific and Cambria.

Thursday 9.
Rainy. A.M. clear. stowed 25 Hls in
Main Hatch which chokes them off.

Friday 10
Light variable winds. and thick weather
on cliff rocks. setting up shooks. A.M. Foggy Rain
Gunning with Pacific.

Foggy. Gunning with Florida
4 ships. A.M. Calm. Foggy

Sunday 12
Calm. Calm. A.M. do. do Foggy

Monday 13.
Light from N. ran into Fabius Har-
bor. while lying here had a gale from S.E. The
L & B. Boats got ashore on Frenchmans Bluff
where the nearly starved, among S. and Savages.
The Bow Boat Got 2 whales, one before and one
after the Gale. The last one we got the 20th the other
we lost. Boiled him out. he made 20 Hls. The Ship
Got under weigh the 18th. The S & B. boats on a 4 day
cruise, to Town Olar, Tarrick. got aboard the ship
20th. Saw the U. S. S. Hancock, and Adaline
Gibbs in Fabius Harbor. 22nd we are now abreast
of Fabius Harbor. with a light S.E. wind.

A.M. Thick Rainy weather and a dead calm
7 A.M. lowered for whales, and the W.B. struck
Thursday 23.

12 Got him alongside. 3 began to
cut. 7 finished. Fresh from S.E. double reefed
Rainy. 10 A.M. started the work.

Friday 24
Light winds. Boiling. A.M. calm
3 ships in sight. Stowed 45 Hls in aft hole
starboard.

Saturday 25
Calm light weather Boiling. 4
ships in sight. 5 A.M. finished 120 Hls. Calm.

Sunday 26
Calm light weather. light W. winds
running into Town Olar. on N.E. Bay. A.M.
spoke Cambria, cutting a whale.
