weigh and run to W. under 2 reefs.

Wednesday 29.

By the wind on diff. Tacks. foggy.
A.M. run into Sabine Harbor. 6 ships in here.

Saturday September 1st

Foggy. A.M. got under weigh and
stood out into the Bay.

Fresh from S.W. with a very heavy
swell. A.M. fine. Whaling. Bow Boat struck
and parted.

Whaling. Saw nothing. A.M. 5 got under
weigh and stood out into the Bay.

Fine. Clear weather and small
breeze from S.W. by the wind on diff. Tacks.
4 ships, and 100 sacks in sight. A.M. fine
from S.E. Spoke Cambria. Samming.

Monday 10

Spoke the Pacific. Small. 5 ships
in sight. fresh from S.E. by on diff. Tacks. un-
der 2 reefs. A.M. moderate. made all sail.

Tuesday 11

Calm. A.M. fine from S.E. 7 ships.

Wednesday 12

Light from S.E. A.M. do. do.

Thursday 13

Freshen from S.E. 4 Blows a Gale.
Lying to under storm sails. A.M. moderating
made sail. Thick rainy weather. 1 ship in
sight.

Friday 14

Fine from S.W. working to windward
on diff. Tacks. A.M. Light winds. 2 ships -

Saturday 15

Light calm weather. 2 ships in
sight. A.M. light W. winds. Foggy.

Sunday 16

Calm foggy weather. A.M. do. do

Monday 17

Light W. winds. steering in to S.E.
6 luffed to the wind. Fog. Sale to S. 20 miles.

Tuesday 18

Calm. Foggy weather. A.M. do do

Wednesday 19

Strong from S.W. 3 close reefed
topsails. Fore & Main Spencer to weather
Bow Head. Gland. 4 Tack in Fore & Main
Tops. blowed away our Fore Staysail. The Mast-
room in sight (astern) 4 miles. A.M. moderating
under 2 reefs & Foresail.
