

Ship D. Wood in the Gulf of St. Lawrence 1855.
Thursday September 21.

Light variable winds, all sail set. Hauling with the Metacom. A.M. stood in, within 8 miles of Green Isle and sent 3 Boats in shoal. Saw nothing. Saw the A. Gibbs Boiling in Frenchman's Bay.

Friday 21

Light S.W. winds. 4 the Boats came aboard. A.M. light variable, working over to Jeanette Bay. Spoke Satel. Tucker 950.

Saturday 22

Light W. winds. Spoke Coal. Manchester 1000 bbls. Came to an anchor in Jeanette Bay with the Metacom.

Sunday 23

Whaling with the Metacom.

Thursday 27.

The Metacom got me, and our L.S. struck at the same time. Got them alongside. A.M. cut him in. 2 Boats whaling.

Friday 28. Commenced boiling. Whaling.

Monday October 1st

Commenced stowing in after hold. Star-side. Stowed 100 bbls. 20 bbls in Tanks recd 8 bbls from Metacom. the proceeds of making, which we run into the Tanks. also.

Tuesday 2.

Calm. Rainy weather. A.M. washed ship, going through the process "Sentimentally". Fore & Aft.

Wednesday 3

Calm Rainy weather. A.M. strong from E. with Snow. Made a new Spanker Boom, from a spar we got from Metacom.

Friday October 5.

A.M. Thick rainy weather. 6 Col under weigh, with a fresh breeze from E. Snow - Storm. Flood out to S.W. Saturday 6.

Fresh from S.E. by to S.S.W. under 2 Reefed Tops middle. Moderating. A.M. made all sail. Rainy - course S.W.

Sunday 7. Left the Gulf of St. Lawrence.

Fine E. winds by to S.S.E. all sail. A.M. fresh from S.E. Thick rainy weather double reefed.

Monday 8. Lat 55.00 N Long 150.30 E.

Wind at S.S.W. by to S.E. 8 passed a ship on the other tack. Middle rainy. A.M. clear. cleaned the Oy-Works.

Tuesday 9

Fresh from S.S.W. by to W. took in light sail. Blowed away the 7th Jib 6 double reefed, furl'd Jib & Mainsail.

9 furl'd Fore & Main Tops. 8 Foresail. Close reefed Main Topsail. A.M. blow a Gale from S.S.E. bying to. Rain Rain -

Wednesday 10.

Took the wind from W. bying to heading to S. A.M. moderating, under double keels Jib & Mainsail. by the wind to S.E.

Thursday 11

Fresh from S. by to E. under 2 Reefs Jib & Mainsail. Middle squally with rain. A.M. furl'd Fore & Main Tops and Foresail. Close reefed Main Tops. 6 wind at W. N. W. kept off S. by E. Moderating making sail.

Lat 52.30 N Long 152.53 E.
