Monday November 5

Light from S.E. by on cliff
Tacks all sail set. A.M. Light from E.S.E. by to S.E.
all sail set. Washing and drying Bone
Tarring Foot ropes and Luffs &c &c
Lat 31.55. Long 155.57 W.

Tuesday 6
Fine from E.S.E. Washing Bone Tarring
A.M. by to S.E. Washing Bone, Rattling &c &c.
Lat 29.30 N Long 157.50 W.

Wednesday 7
Fine from E.S.E. by to S.E. all sail set.
Washing Bone Rattling &c &c. A.M. back from by
to S.E. Mending Rattling. Tarring &c. Split the jib
sent it in and commenced repairing it
Lat 27.15 N Long 155.39 W.

Thursday 8
Breeze from E.S.E. by to S.E. light sails
furled. mending jib sent it. A.M. heading by
the wind to S.E. & S.E.S. drying Bone and stowing
it down, the Main hoisted.
Lat 24.14 N Long 155.14 W

Friday 9
Breeze from E.S.E. by to S.E. 7 kept off S.S.E.
A.M. Fresh. 2 Keel. by the wind to S.E. S. & S.S.E.
Lat 21.06 N Long 154.55.

Saturday 10
Fresh from E. by to S.S.E. 4 Took in the jib.
A.M. fine. & saw the Land. passed a ship.
10 took a Pill. Light winds

Sunday 11
Light S.E. winds and a heavy swell
steering in to Beyond Bay. 3 P.M. came to an
anchor in Hoils Harbour 12 ships lying here.

At Anchor in Hoils. Nov 11/53.
Took 11 days liberty each watch. Got off 150 lbs
water. Painted ship inside and out. Got off
20 lbs Sweet Potatoes. &c &c. set the Cambria
have a new Boat, and sold an old one.
Got off some small stores &c &c &c &c
December. Thursday 5

at 8 A.M. have shot to
a foul anchor, let go the other, and cleared
and stowed the first. 9. made sail. took one
anchor and stood out of the harbor. the wind
at 10. 11. discharged Pitt. clearing decks washing off

Friday 7
at 2 P.M. took a fine breeze from S.E.
course S.S.W. 3 kept off W.S.W. running the
shore down, 6 miles East out. 5 P.M. took in the
light sails. 2 Keel. Topsails furled jib. heaved to
the wind, heading E.S.E. 2 A.M. wore ship. daylights
made all sail. Light calm weather, and wind
down the Land to N.E. & N.W.

Saturday 8
Light winds from E. running along
the Land, 6 miles distant. Painted the Star-
Board. A.M. Light N.W. wind. standing into
the Land.

Sunday 9
Fine N.W. breeze, standing into the
Land. 2 raised Staewahae 3 hauled aback, within
a mile of the reef, and the Captain went ashore
with 2 Boats, Pitt on board. Towed off in a
Launch 10 lbs Beef and 25 lbs Potatoes.
10 took a light breeze from E. course N. off shore.
Took in fine breeze from E.S.E. course W.S.W.
A.M. fine saw Kainai. Morotoi and Moani.
Calm Calm.
