Tuesday, January 22.

Light breeze at E. course
The Saratoga in sight. minding the Main
Topsail. Bent it. Saw Killis and Black Fish.
A.M. fine at E. I raised Sunday Island.
to W. minding Main Spunkers.

Lat 24.10 S. Long 176.20 W.

Wednesday 23

Fine at E. running along shore
5 miles distant. 4h. spoke the Saratoga.
hailed aback and the Skippers went in fishing.
★ They stopped ashore all night. sent the Boats off.
Off and On. daylight sent 2 Boats in shore.

Thursday 24. Off and On. 4h. the Boats came off
haced forward to S.W. A.M. by the wind to S. with a
W.S.W. The S. in sight. Ciled the Starboard chain.

Lat 29.50 S. Long 176.58 W.

Friday 25.

Fine breeze at N.S.W. by the wind to S.
2 Raised Boat, Island to S. a large smoke on
it. The Woods on fire probably. Saw a sail on wea-
ther Beam. afterwards saw her 4 Boats down. at dark
she luffed to aback. Ciled the Starboard chain.
5h. Tacked ship to N.W. The Saratoga in sight.
7h. Tacked back. A.M. fine breeze at N.W. by S. Boat.
R Macauleys Isle and Curtis Rocks in sight. a Bark
and ship in sight.

Lat 34.10 S. Long 176.46 W.

Saturday 26

Fine breeze at N.W. by to S. 4h spoke
Massachusetts of Santucket. Pickersoon. had been
ashore on Goat Isle 2 days before and set the hatch
on fire. spoke Saratoga. Light Winds. A.M. do.
Panoramy employed. The S. in sight.

Sunday 27

Light breeze at S.W. by the wind to N.W.
The Saratoga in sight. Met Wood & Co. A.M. fine
breeze at S.W. by the wind to S.S.E. 4 ships in sight
to windward

Monday 28

Fine breeze N.S.W. by the to S. Rain
squalls. 4 ships in sight. 7h. spoke the Saratoga
A.M. fresh at N.S.W. by the wind to S. hauled
light sails. 2 Reefed the Fore Topsail.

Lat 33.30 S. Long 179.00 W.

Tuesday 29

Fresh at N.S.W. by to S. under 2 Reef.
5h. hauled the Main sail. The S. in sight.
Fresh from W. A.M. by the wind to S. under
2 Reef.

Lat 34.38.

Wednesday 30

Fresh at S.S.E. by the wind to S.W.
under 2 Reefed Topsails. 13h. hauled Jib and
Main sail. 8h. do Foresail. Strong breeze with
Rain. a heavy S.W. swell. A.M. fresh. made sail.
14h. 2 Reefed.

Lat 36.18 S. Long 179.13 W.

Thursday 31

Fresh at N.S.W. by the wind to S. under
2 Reef. Jib and Main sail. 1 spoke the Saratoga.
4h. spoke William Wirt. Ashley. bound homel. 3
days from Bay of Islands. 5h. hauled J. & M.
a very heavy swell from S.W. A.M. light winds
from N.W. to S. under single reef. Jib and
Main sail. a very heavy swell from S.W. The S. in
sight.

Lat 36.20 S. Long 179.31 W.
