Rigging.

Wednesday 7.

Fine breezes at E.S.E. course S.W. S.
employed in the Fore Rigging. all sail
set. Royals and Studding Sails. &c. &c. A.M.
light breezes at S.E. and N.E. Rain squalls. Turn
ed in Fore and Main Topmast Backstays.
and set up Star side of Topmast Rigging.

Thursday 8.

Light Breezes at S.E. and E. course
S.W. S. employed on Main Topmast Back-
stays and Rigging. Royals and Stun Sails -
A.M. light at E.S.E. employed in the Rigging -
Tarring down &c. &c.

Lat 17.55 N Long 50.55 W

Friday 9

Light breezes at E.S.E. course S.W. S.
Royals and Stun sails employed in the Rigging.
A.M. do. do. unbent the new jib and bent the
old one. 1 sail in sight steering W. commenced
Bunching Bone.

Lat 19.10 N Long 52.28 W

Saturday 10

Light breezes and fine beautiful
weather from E.S.E. course S.W. S. under all
sail. Royals and Stun sails Bunching Bone
5th finished 115 Bunches. It takes up much
less room than ^{about the same room} when in Bulk. 2 sails in
sight steering W and S.W. A.M. Fine breezes at
E. course S.W. all sail. Stun sails. washed ship
outside.

Sunday May 11.

Fine breezes at E. course S.W.
Gave her a sentimental washing inside fore
and aft. A.M. light at S.E. 2 sails in sight to W.

Altered the Chronometer rate to 16 sec. per 10.
she having gained 4.44 in 15 days.

Monday 12

Light at S.E. course S.W. S. 2 sails in
sight hauled to W. A.M. Light at E.S.E. course
S.W. S. Painting Ship inside and the Top Rails
outside. one sail in sight.

Lat 23.38 N Long 57.15 W

Tuesday 13

Light E. winds, course S.W. S. Paint-
ing ship. one sail in sight steering to S.W. A.M.
light S.E. wind. course S.W. S. Painting Ship.
1 sail in sight. steering S.W.

Lat 25.00 N Long 59.01 W

Wednesday 14

Light breezes at S.E. course S.W. S.
everything set. Variously employed. sail in sight
middle pt. wind at S.E. A.M. 4th took the wind
at S.W. which hauled to S. 10th took the wind
at S.W. 12th to S.W. hauled - 12th & 4th & 8th in S.E. Sails.
2 sails in sight. Rainy, squally thick weather.

Thursday 15

Fine breezes with squalls at S.W. S.
No. 1 & 2 set. By the. to S.W. a very heavy S.E. swell.
one sail in sight. A.M. fresh steady breeze
at S.E. all sail. course S.W. S. 1 sail in sight.
Painting Tops &c. &c. &c.
