 ening at 7 P.M. took reef in the topsails. at 9 P.M. took in the
 mainsail & jib. At 1 P.M. wind shifted W. by S. & the
 wind abating made sail. 2 sails in sight.

 latter part squally with rain.

 ening at 1 P.M. took in the light sails. At 9 A.M. heavy
 squalls with rain double-reefed the topsails.

Strong wind from the steering &c. by S. Middle part strong.
 Latter part more moderate made all sail.

Thursday Aug. 3rd

Commenced with light wind from the steering &c. Middle part
 calm. Latter part light wind from the steering &c. by S.

Friday Aug. 4th

Calm. Landed the boats for exercise. At 8 P.M. a breeze sprung
 up from the steering &c. by S. At 10 P.M. lowered for sperm whales

Lat. 49.24 Long. 39.35

Saturday Aug. 5th

At 5 P.M. struck a sperm whale at 4 P.M. took him to the
 ship. Shortened sail and got ready to cut. At daylight
 commenced to cut got him in and made sail.

Sunday Aug. 6th

Light variable winds. At 1 P.M. lowered for sperm whales
 started at once but did not fasten. At 5 P.M. came on board
 and commenced to boil.

 clearing away the head. At sunset finished boiling.
 At daylight made all sail steering S.W.
