Whale Ship Lion outward bound Wm H. Hardwick

Remarks on board ship Lion Wednesday Aug 9th

Light wind from W. steering S. Turned up the starboard
boat and painted her. Broke out for provisions also.

Lat. 50.06 Long. 52.45

Thursday Aug 10th

Light wind from W. steering S. At daylight raised
the Isle of Flores one of the Western Islands. At 11
the Capt. went ashore.

Friday Aug 11th

Light wind laying off and on. At 3 PM squally with rain.
Took 2 seals in the topsail. At 6 PM the boat came off bring-
ing a few onions & potatoes. Letter post strong wind and
clear. Spoke the Matthew Sizer of New Bedford. Breaking
out for molasses.

Saturday Aug 12th

Boat began working up to the boat. The Capt. seeing there
was dissatisfaction amongst the men, called all hands aft
and asked who wished to leave the ship and take 2 suits
of clothes with them. William B. Thomas a cooper, James
Earle, Wm Miller Patrick C. Brien Alexander Madison Mark B.
man, and James Phillips were reported a wish to go.

Sunday Aug 13th

Light wind laying off and on. Boating back and forth
from the ship to the shore.

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Remarks on board ship Lion Monday Aug 14th

Light wind laying off on. At 1 PM 2 boats came with
potatoes and onions. The Mate went ashore at 2 PM with
the men who wished to be left. At 7 AM the Mate
came off with 7 Portuguese to go with us. Boats came off
with potatoes and onions.

Tuesday Aug 15th

Laying off on 2 boat loads of potatoes and onions At 6 PM
kept off S.W. wind S.W. at daylight kept off S.W.
Coast & stores in sight. 2 sails in sight.

Wednesday Aug 16th

Strong wind from W. steering S.W. At sunset shortened
sail and luffed to the wind. At daylight made sail
and steered S.

Lat. 50.58 Long. 56.38

Thursday Aug 17th

Fine breeze from S.W. steering S.W. At 1 PM raised the Isle
of Fayal. Employed coopers oil. At 9 AM the Capt. went
ashore.

Friday Aug 18th

At sunset the boat came off. Stood out to sea. At daylight
stood in. At 9 AM the boat came off for the oil. 125 gal.

Saturday Aug 19th

Laying off and on the boat came off bringing 4 Portuguese
to go with us. Discharged the Edward and Leonard
from a sailor.
