Remarks on board ship from Monday Dec. 6th
Moderate gale from N. steering E. by S. At 7 AM took in the
fore topsail. Middle part strong gale at 2 PM close
reefed the main topsail and furl'd the fore sail
and luff'd to the wind. At daylight more moderate
kept off E. by S. and made some sail.

Thursday Dec. 7th

Strong wind from N. by E. steering E. by S. made some more sail
At 5 PM hauled up E. by S. Middle part moderate gale from
west took in the fore topsail. latter part strong gale
from W. with a very heavy sea running. At 11 PM close reefed
the main topsail, furl'd the fore sail, and luff'd by the
wind.

Friday Dec. 8th

Moderate gale from N. heading E. by S. set the fore sail and
turn'd one reef out of the main topsail. latter part
light wind from N. heading E. by S. made all sail.
Employed filling up casks with salt water.
