of New Bedford. Started 1000 lbs and pork.

Saturday Feb 17th

Boat hoys from S. At 1 PM was ship heading W.
at 4 PM wind increasing took in the light sails and
put 2 reefs in fore and mizzen topsails At 2.30 A.M.
was ship heading S by E.

Sunday Feb 18th

Strong wind from W. heading S. At 3 PM wind shifted
to S. steering W by E took 2 reefs in main topsail fore
main sail and jib Latter part more moderate made
tail. Saw the east coast of New Zealand.

Sunday Feb 20th

Moderate wind from S. working to S. by E. Latter
part light variable winds and calm.

Light wind from W. heading S. At 4 PM hoys
from S. steering W. by S. Latter part wind from W.
saw the land.

Lat. 36.21 Long 175.32

Tuesday Feb 22nd

Light variable air working up to Auckland At
4 PM sent the chains and got the anchors off the
boat At 11 AM came to an anchor in 9 fathoms water
with 60 fathoms chain

Thursday Feb 24th

Sent the oil ashore. Getting ready to stow wood.

Friday Feb 25th

A boat came alongside with 14,967 lbs potatoes and
