Remarks on board ship Lion Friday June 1st

Light wind from S.W. steering N.W. by E. Latter part light variable and employed making spungers and stunsils. (No Obs.)

Saturday June 2nd

Light wind from S.W. steering N.W. by E. Latter part fresh breeze from N.W. heading N.W.

Lat. 32.21 Long 165.03

Sunday June 3rd

Fresh breeze from N.W. heading N.W. At 2 P.M. took in the light sails and put 2 reefs in the topsails. Latter part moderate wind made all sail.

Lat. 32.47 Long 165.02

Monday June 4th

Fresh breeze from N.W. heading N.W. Took in the light sails. Latter part fresh breeze with frequent showers of rain put 2 reefs in the topsails. Started a cask of bread.

Lat. 33.04 Long 165.07

Tuesday June 5th

Fresh breeze with showers of rain from N.W. heading N.W. Middle part squally heading N.W. put the ship under short sail. Latter part light from N.W. heading N.W. by E. made all sail. Employed variously.

Lat. 33.27 Long 165.23

Wednesday June 6th

Light wind from N.W. heading N.W. by E. Middle part fresh breeze from N.W. heading N.W. Latter part squally took in the light sails and took 2 reefs in the topsails. Started a cask of meat. (No Obs.)

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Remarks on board ship Lion Thursday June 7th

Fresh breeze from N.W. heading N.W. by E. Middle part strong wind with heavy squalls from S. steering N.W. by E. At 8 P.M. heaved to the wind under a close sized main top sail heading N.W.

Friday June 8th

Moderate gales with frequent rain squalls from S. heading N.W.

Lat. 31.45 Long 165.02

Saturday June 9th

Moderate gales from S. heading N.W. At 3 P.M. wore ship heading S.W. by E. Latter part strong gales with rain squalls.

Lat. 31.25 Long 165.19

Sunday June 10th

Strong gales from S.W. heading S. Latter part near moderate At 8 A.M. wore ship and made some sail heading N.

Lat. 31.10 Long 165.04

Monday June 11th

Strong wind from S.W. heading N. Latter part heading N.W. Employed minding the spunk. Started 3 bbls of meat.

Lat. 30.25 Long 165.07

Tuesday June 12th

Strong wind from N.W. heading N.W. by E. At 3 P.M. kept off N.W. Middle part moderate made all sail. Latter part fresh breeze from N.W. heading N.W. Took in the light sails. Employed variously.
