Remarks on board Ship *Leon* Friday July 5th
 Strong wind from E. heading S. under single reefed top
 sail. At sunset shot and sail. At 12 M. kept off light
 and made sail. At daylight made the Island of
 Santa Cruz.

Saturday July 6th
 Laying off and on trading with the Natives for guns
 and other things. At 10 kept off light.

Sunday July 7th
 Fresh breeze from E by S. Steering light. At sunset luffed
 to the wind aback. At 1 A.M. backed forward. Latter
 part squally with considerable rain. The Charles Maher
 in the rigging and flogged him.

Monday July 8th
 Fresh breeze from E heading S. under all sail.
 Latter part heading N. Employed picking over guns
 and stowing them away.

Tuesday July 9th
 Strong wind from E. heading N. but creeps in the
 topsails. Latter part moderate heading N. under all
 sail. Started a little of meat.

Lat. 7.09 Long 165.30

Wednesday July 10th
 Fresh breeze from E heading N. Latter part light wind
 from N. heading light. At 11 wind ship heading E. S.
 Employed cleaning and painting iron work.

Lat. 6.00 Long 165.35

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Remarks on board Ship *Leon* Thursday July 12th
 Light wind with calm heading E. S. Employed
 mending the mizzen top sail and painting iron work.

Friday July 13th
 Light air from E. heading S. S. Latter part moder-
 ate breeze with frequent showers of rain heading
 N. Employed mending the mizzen top sail.

Lat. 5.24 Long 165.35

Saturday July 14th
 Fresh breeze with rain squalls from E by S heading
 N. by S. Bent the mizzen top sail. Latter part calm.

Lat. 4.23 Long 165.47

Sunday July 15th
 Light variable air working to N. Employed variously
 in ship duty.

Lat. 4.21 Long 165.39

Monday July 16th
 Light variable air working to N. Latter part moderate
 wind with great quantity of rain. Started meat.

 Light variable air working to N. Latter part calm.
 Employed painting ship.

Lat. 4.18 Long 165.40

Wednesday July 18th
 Commenced calm. Latter part moderate wind from E.
 heading N. Employed painting ship.
