Employed fitting rigging.

wind and squally with rain. Latter part calm.

Light wind from N. steering S. Middle part variable

Monday Sept 10th

Light wind from N.W. heading S.W. Latter part strong
wind from E.W. heading S. Employed variously.

Tuesday Sept 11th

Fresh breeze from S.W. heading S.W. Latter part strong
wind. Double reefed the topsails. Employed variously.

Lat. 7.00 Long 165.26

Wednesday Sept 12th

Strong wind from N.W. heading S.W. Employed variously.

Thursday Sept 13th

Strong wind from N.W. heading S.W. Latter part more mod-
erate made sail steering S.W. by E.

Fresh breeze from S.W. steering N.W. At 11 AM raised the

Light breeze from S.W. heading S.W. At sunset stood off head-
ing N.W. with a fresh breeze from S.W.

Sunday Sept 16th

Fresh breeze from S.W. heading S.W. At 5 PM saw Pennell
Islands to the N.W. At daylight stood in for the land
sent 2 boats in to trade but got nothing. Made
a catch of bread and 1 bl of meat.

Monday Sept 17th

Light variable wind with light rain working off
shore. Latter part fresh breeze from S.W. steering S.W.
Employed variously.

Lat. 12.35 Long 167.41

Tuesday Sept 18th

Fresh breeze from S.W. steering S.W. by E. Latter part wind
from N.W. heading S.W. by the wind. Employed variously.

Lat. 14.25 Long 168.34

Wednesday Sept 19th

Fresh breeze from S.W. heading S.W. Latter part head-
ing S. Employed variously.
