Remarks on board Ship Lion Thursday Sept. 20th

Fresh breeze from S. heading S.W. Latter part wind from E. heading E. Employed variously.

Friday Sept. 21st

Moderate wind from E. heading E. Latter part wind from E. steering S.W. Employed variously.

Lat. 44.22 Long. 155.50

Saturday Sept. 22nd

Moderate breeze from E. steering S.W. Latter part steering S.W. Employed variously.

Lat. 46.38 Long. 155.42

Sunday Sept. 23rd

Light wind from E. steering S.W. Latter part calm. Employed variously in ship duty.

Lat. 48.14 Long. 157.12

Monday Sept. 24th

Light variable air, working to S. Latter part fresh breeze from S. heading S.W. under double reefed topsails. Employed variously.

Lat. 50.12 Long. 157.00

Tuesday Sept. 25th

Strong breeze from S. heading S.W. Latter part moderate breeze from E. steering S.W. Employed variously.

Lat. 52.22 Long. 156.57

Wednesday Sept. 26th

Moderate breeze from E. heading S.W. under all sails. Latter part fresh breeze from S. steering S.W. by S. Started 3 bbls of meat. Found another bad barrel of beef being the fifth one that was not fit to eat, besides many others that part was bad.

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Remarks on board Ship Lion Thursday Sept. 27th

Fresh breeze from the N. steering S.W. through the night going under easy sail. Employed variously.

Lat. 56.55 Long. 157.50

Friday Sept. 28th

Fresh breeze from N.W. steering S.W. Middle part rainy wind from N. Latter part wind from S. At 11 A.M. raised sperm whales.

Lat. 58.15 Long. 158.20

Saturday Sept. 29th

Fresh breeze from N. steering off after the whales. At 1 P.M. lowered the boats, struck a large whale and lost the line. Through the night heading S.W. under easy sail. At daylight went ship and made sail heading S.W.

Lat. 57.24 Long. 158.48

Sunday Sept. 30th

Light air from S. heading S.W. going under easy sail through the night. Latter part fresh breeze from N.W. steering S.W. under easy sail.

Lat. 58.04 Long. 159.28

Monday Oct. 1st

Fresh breeze from N.W. steering S.W. Middle part strong breeze and squally from the N. with rain thunder and lightning heading N.W. by E. under short sail. Latter part light breeze from S. started a cask of bread and flour.
