

Ship Lion off Cape Horn - Land 11° 20' S. 70° 10' W.

Remarks on board Ship Lion Friday Oct. 12th

Strong wind from N. heading S.W. under short sail.
At 3 P.M. moderate wind from N. with rain squalls heading S.W. At sundown the Pyramid bearing N. by E. dist. 2 miles. The end of the Island bearing N. by E. dist. 30 miles. At 10 P.M. moderate gales from N. took in to storm sail. heading N. by E. At 11 A.M. saw the land bearing N. by E. dist. 35 miles. W. M. on moderate.

Lat. 31.20 Long 157.35

Saturday Oct. 13th

Strong breeze from N. heading N. by E. made some sail. At 2 P.M. wind ship heading S.W. Middle part more moderate made sail accordingly. At daylight made all sail heading N. by E. At 10 A.M. wind ship heading N. by E. for the land.

Lat. 31.17 Long 157.25

Sunday Oct. 14th

Light variable air working in toward the land. Middle part light breeze from the N. steering in for the land. At 8 A.M. the boat went ashore, at 9 A.M. the boat returned, and went in pursuit of humpbacks got a boat store and man's boots and no fish. Latter part strong breeze carrying sail accordingly.

Monday Oct. 15th

Strong wind from N. working up to the land. Middle part light wind. At 2 A.M. strong wind with rain thunder and lightning. Latter part moderate wind and cloudy. At 10 A.M. the boat went ashore discharged Samuel Johnson.

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Remarks on board Ship Lion Tuesday Oct. 16th

Strong wind with rain laying off and on. At 2 P.M. the boat came off. stood out by the wind heading N. by E. At 3 P.M. spoke the Sea Gull of New Bedford. At 3 A.M. wind shifted to N. steered in for the land in company with the other ships. 2 other sails in sight.

Wednesday Oct. 17th

Strong wind from N. heading S.W. At 3 P.M. wind increasing put the ship under snug sail. At 5 P.M. wind ship heading N. by E. At daylight wind ship heading N. by E. made some sail. The land bearing N. by E. dist. 25 miles. Employed mending boat. 2 sails in sight.

Lat. 31.28 Long 157.10

Thursday Oct. 18th

Strong wind from N. heading S.W. Latter part moderate gales 2 sails in sight to windward.

Lat. 32.02 Long 156.05

Friday Oct. 19th

Moderate gales from N. heading S.W. At 1 P.M. wind ship heading N. by E. Middle part moderate heading N. by E. Latter part moderate gales with rain squalls. The Sea Gull in sight to windward.

Lat. 31.51 Long 157.42

Saturday Oct. 20th

Moderate gales with rain squalls from N. heading N. by E. At 4 P.M. wind ship heading S. At sundown the Island in sight bearing N. by E. dist. 25 miles. Latter part more moderate made some sail heading N. by E.

Lat. 31.49 Long 157.16
