 Strong wind from E. heading them for the land. At
 6 P.M. spoke the Sea Gull. Latter part moderate all
 sail set. At 8.30 M. lowered for humpbacks without
 success.

 Light wind from S. laying off and on. At 7 A.M. lowered
 for humpbacks without success. At 10 A.M. spoke the
 Chin Ender and the Gull of New Bedford.

Tuesday Oct. 23^d
 Moderate breeze from E. laying off and on the land. At
 sunset stood off by the wind under short sail, heading
 N by E. At daylight made all sail with a fresh breeze.
 Started a catch of brack.

Wednesday Oct. 24th
 Fresh breeze from the E. heading N by E. At 8 P.M. spoke the
 Sea Gull of New Bedford and Cameron of Sydney.
 At 10 P.M. wore ship heading N by E under short sail.
 At daylight wore ship heading N by E made all sail.

Thursday Oct. 25th
 Fresh breeze from E. steering N.W. through the
 night steering N. under short sail. At daylight
 made all sail steering N.W. Started 5 bbls. of meat.

 Fresh breeze from S.W. steering N.W. Middle part strong
 breeze steering N.W. under short sail. Latter part
 fresh breeze from N.W. heading N. under all sail.

Saturday Oct. 27th
 Fresh breeze from N.W. heading N. At sunset
 shortened sail. At daylight sailing with the wind in
 and lightning. Latter part calm. The Sea Gull
 in sight. Employed variously.

Sunday Oct. 28th
 Fresh breeze from S.W. steering N.W. At sunset
 strong wind luffed to under short sail heading
 N.W. At daylight made moderate made sail
 At 8.30 M. spoke the Sea Gull and kept off N.W.

Monday Oct. 29th
 Fresh breeze from S.W. steering N.W. At sunset luffed
 to the wind under short sail, heading N.W. by E.
 At daylight made sail heading N.W.

Lat. 29.16 Long. 152.53

Tuesday Oct. 30th
 Fresh breeze from S.W. heading N. At sunset wore
 ship heading N. Under short sail. Latter part strong
 breeze with light rain squally carrying easy sail.
 Employed variously.
