 Whaler Ship Lion off Good Hope Island 17th Dec. 1882

Remarks on board ship Lion Friday Dec. 21st

Strong breeze from N.W. heading N.W. At 5 PM wind shifted to N. with ship heading N.W. Latter part light wind from N. steering in for the land. Employed clearing up the run.
 Lat. 35.57 Long. 159.23

Saturday Dec. 22nd

Light wind from N. heading N. Middle part strong breeze from N. heading E. under short sail. The land in sight to N. dist. 22 miles. Latter part raining.
 Lat. 36.37 Long. 160.42

Sunday Dec. 23rd

Light wind from N.W. heading N.W. for the land under short sail. Latter part fresh breeze from S. steering in for the land. At 1 PM the boat went ashore. Started a bag of butter.

Monday Dec. 24th

Strong breeze from S. laying off and on. At sunset the boat came off. At 8 AM went ashore again. The Oliver Crocker off New Bedford laying off and on also.

Tuesday Dec. 25th

Strong breeze from S. laying off and on. At sunset the boat came off bringing potatoes and onions. Food heading N.W. Middle part calm. Latter part light wind from N. heading N. 4 sails in sight.

Light wind from N. heading E. At 6 PM spoke the Martha of New Bedford. Middle part fresh breeze under short sail. At 10 AM raining with light wind under all sail. Started 30 lbs of meat.

Thursday Dec. 27th

Partly breeze from S.W. heading S. At sunset shortened sail. Latter part strong breeze from E. steering N.W. 2 sails in sight.

Lat. 37.52 Long. 158.36

Friday Dec. 28th

Strong breeze from E. steering N.W. under double reefed topsails. At 5 PM spoke the Oliver Crocker of New Bedford. Latter part heading N.W. by the wind. 3 sails in sight.

Lat. 38.10 Long. 157.44

Saturday Dec. 29th

Strong breeze from E. heading S. At 4 PM spoke the Edward Barry of Nantucket and Oliver Crocker of New Bedford. Latter part wind from E. steering N.W. 2 sails in sight.

Lat. 38.35 Long. 156.28

Sunday Dec. 30th

Strong breeze from S.W. steering S. At 3 PM spoke the Martha of New Bedford. Shifted to the wind heading S. Latter part moderate breeze with thick cloudy weather heading E. 4 sails.

Lat. 36.23 Long. 155.44
