Remarks on board Ship Ship Sunday Jan. 27th
 Strong breeze from N. steering E under easy
 sail. At 5 PM spoke a light whaling ship.
 Middle part moderate wind from N. under
 all sail. Latter part fresh breeze steering S.E.
 1 sail in sight to N. West another 1/2.

Lat 34, 25 Long. 175, 31

Sunday Jan. 28th

Strong breeze from N. steering S.E. At 1.30 PM
 took in the light sails and put 2 reefs in the
 topsails and luffed to the wind brading 1/2.
 At 2 PM light rain squalls. Middle part brading
 S.E. Latter part fresh breeze from N.W. steering
 to S. by the wind. At 9 AM saw the Barrier and
 several other islands on the east coast of
 New Zealand. Employed mending the rig.

Tuesday Jan. 29th

Fresh breeze from N. working up to the land. At 6 AM
 went in to the entrance of Auckland. Latter part
 working up on opposite tacks taking in and making
 sail according to the breeze.

Wednesday Jan. 30th

Strong breeze from N. working up the Hauraki Gulf
 on opposite tacks at daylight got the anchors off the bow
 and brat the chain. Taking in and making sail
 according to the breeze.

Remarks on board Ship Ship Thursday Jan. 31st

Strong wind from N. with rain. At 1 PM left off N.E.
 and stood out the gulf stowed the anchors and
 chains. At 7 PM mod moderate and clear commencing
 to work up again. At 9 AM entered the gulf.

Friday Feb. 1st

Fresh breeze from N. working up on opposite tacks
 at 6 PM brat the chains. Latter light wind
 from N. under all sail.

Saturday Feb. 2nd

Light wind from N. working up the gulf on
 opposite tacks. At 4 PM got the anchors already to let go.
 At 8 PM came to an anchor in the gulf in 24
 fathoms water and 60 fathoms chain. At 3 AM got
 under weigh with a fresh breeze from N.W. and
 stood up to Auckland. At 11 AM came to an anchor
 in 5 fathoms water with both anchors 60 fathoms
 chain on one end and 25 on the other.

Sunday Feb. 3rd

Fresh breeze from N. with clear weather. One watch
 ashore on liberty.

Monday Feb. 4th

Strong breeze from N.W. with frequent rain squalls.
 At daylight the watch came off got ashore a raft
 of cork for water. Employed getting ready for water.
