Remarks on board ship Lion Tuesday Feb. 18th
Light wind from N. Employed sitting up shocks. Broke
out about 8 tons sperm oil.

Wednesday Feb. 20th

Light variable air. Put the oil on board the
schooner Mary. Got off a raft of water.

Thursday Feb. 21st

Fresh breeze from N. Employed sitting up shocks
and drawing water. Got off 5 cwt. of sugar.

Friday Feb. 22nd

Moderate breeze from N. Employed sitting up shocks
Received on board 10 tons of fir wood. And watch
on liberty.

Saturday Feb. 23rd

Light variable air with calm. Got off 2 tons of bread
and 2 tons of flour. Frank Frater, Peter, Joacquin
and Francisco got deserted.

Sunday Feb. 24th

Fresh breeze from S. Latter part raining. And watch
on liberty. Buonaparte deserted.

Monday Feb. 25th

Fresh breeze from E. with rain. And watch on liberty.
Cook, Blacksmith & Parker deserted.

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Remarks on board ship Lion Tuesday Feb. 25th

Fresh breeze from E. with rain squalls. Employed
variously.

Wednesday Feb. 27th

Fresh breeze from E. Employed variously in port-
duty.

Thursday Feb. 28th

Light breeze from E. Received on board 3 1/2 tons
potatoes and 4 cwt. onions.

Friday Feb. 29th

Moderate breeze from N. John McQuinn came on
board as steerman & John Green as boatswain.

Saturday Mar. 1st

Moderate breeze from N. Tack up our anchor.

Sunday Mar. 2nd

Moderate breeze from N. At 2 PM got under weigh
and stood down off the North Head came to an
anchor in 10 fathoms water with 50 fathoms chain.

Monday Mar. 3rd

Fresh breeze from E. Henry Ginn came on board
to go as boatswain.

Tuesday Mar. 4th

Moderate breeze from E. N. E. Unbent the jib and
bent another one.
