Fresh breeze from W. steering E. At sunset shortened
sail and luffed to the wind heading S. At

Remarks on board Ship Lion Friday April 4th
Fresh breeze from S. steering off to S.W. after the
ships. At 5 P.M. saw a whale going quick to leeward
lowered for him without success luffed to the wind
under short sail heading E. At 6. Latter part wind
from the E. heading S. by E. At 9 A.M. spoke the Sea-
gull of New Bedford. Sunday & Goat Island in sight

Saturday April 5th

Moderate breeze from S. heading N.W. At 3 P.M.
spoke the Cortis of New Bedford At sunset shortened
sail At 2 A.M. wore ship heading E. S. At day-
light made sail steering S. 3 sails in sight -
Goat & Sunday Island in sight

Sunday April 6th

Light breeze from N. steering S. At sunset
luffed to the wind heading E. S. Latter part
moderate wind from S. steering N. 3 sails in
sight. Sunday & Goat Island in sight.
