Storing S.W. under double reefed Top sail.

the ship under short sail. Latter part moderate
wind storing S.W. under all sail. Employed variously.

Moderate wind from S. Storing S.W. At sunset luffed
to the wind under short sail heading N.W. Latter
part light air under all sail.

Wednesday April 16th

Yerish breeze from N. Storing S.W. Middle part
heading S.W. by the wind. Latter part heading
S. with thick rainy weather under easy sail.
Started a tierce of beef and 1/2 of pork.

Yerish breeze from S. heading S.W. with thick
rainy weather. Latter part strong breeze heading
S. under short sail.

Strong breeze from S.W. with rain heading S.
