At 9 P.M. spoke the Florida of New Bedford the
Isaac Nowland and Safar etc in company.
Luffed to the wind heading N.W. by W. At 8 A.M.
looked for sperm whales but sight of them in
the rain. Several other ships boats in pursuit also.
