Moderate breeze from W. steering N.W. by E. Latter part fresh breeze steering N.W. by E. Employed variously.

Saturday May 31st

Fresh breeze from W. steering N.W. by E. Latter part light wind from E.W. 1 sail in sight to E.

Sunday June 1st

Moderate breeze from W. steering S.W. At 2 PM spoke the Horizon of Hamburgs bound to Sydney. At 5 PM kept off N.W. by E. Latter part fresh breeze from E.

Fresh breeze from E. steering S.W. by W. Middle part steering N.W. Latter part wind from E. with rain squalls At 9 A.M. kept off W. saw two Islands of the Navigator Group.

Tuesday June 3rd

Moderate breeze from E. steering S.W. At 2 PM saw the Island of Gotovillak At sunset luffed to the wind aback heading S.W. At 12 PM wore ship heading N.W. At daylight kept off for the Island. At 8 AM the boat went ashore.

Fresh breeze from E. with rain. At 5 PM strong squalls shortened sail. At sunset the boat came off bringing yards. Latter part fresh breeze working up to the Island under all sail.
