the ESE and squally heading S.E. with all sail
out since 6 o'clock past the 12 mile and
rigger 28

tack ship to the S.W. since 6 o'clock
past strong and pleasant 28

since 6 o'clock past strong 31

Came with strong wind from the S.E.

Came with strong wind from the
S.W. and pleasant steering S.E. since past
gentle wind and rain at 11 o'clock past gentle

and pleasant steering S.E. since past strong
Latter part strong wind from the S.E.
and rigger heading S.E. saw several
sail steering to the Westward to Lat 28.25

Came with strong wind from the South
and rigger at 2 P.M. tack ship to the S.E.
since past gentle wind ship on different tacks
Latter part squally with thunder and lightning and heavy
rain 30

Saturday 30th

Came with squally weather and heavy thunder
and sharp lightning and heavy rain at 5 P.M.
heavy squall from the S.W. double reefed the top sail
steering S.E. since past strong wind from the S.E.
and cloudy latter part light from the South and some
rainy one ship in sight to End Oct 24 44

Sunday 31st

Came with light wind from the Eastward
and rigger heading S.E. with all sail out
since 6 o'clock past light wind from the S.E. and fine
pleasant weather heading S.E. with all sail and
saw two sail steering to the Southward and Eastward
one big steering N.W. by N. by compass 30
