Came with light air from
S.E. and fine pleasant weather heading S.W. with all
sail set. Mid & latter part light wind and pleasant
saw a Ship steering N.W. saw Log Lat 21.42 N
Long 24.55

Tuesday 2nd

Came with light air from the S.E. and
fine pleasant weather heading S.W. at 5 p.m.
lower down the boat & expose the crew
Mid & latter part about the same saw a big steering
S.W. saw Log Lat 20.42 North
Long 20.00 W

Wednesday 3rd

Came with light air from the S.E.
and fine heading S.W. at 5 p.m. lower the boat
& expose the crew. Mid & latter part much
the same. Lat 20.00
Long 30.35

Thursday 4th

Came with light air from the South
and pleasant heading N.W. at 5 p.m. lower
down to try the Whaling gun. it went quite
well. Mid & latter part gentle breeze and fine
weather heading South. Lat 18.25
Long 30.35

Friday 5th

Came with strong wind from East and
cloudy steering S.E. saw a big steering S.W. & the South
Mid & latter part strong and varying from E
to S.E. Lat 16.14 S
Long 30.09 W

Saturday 6th

Came with strong wind from E.N.
and cloudy steering S.E. Mid & latter part strong
and cloudy S.E. Lat 15.40
Long 28.30

Sunday 7th 1847

Came with gentle wind from the
East and cloudy steering S.E. with all sail set.
Mid & latter part about the same out the four
topmast standing sail saw a Bark steering to the S.W. Lat 11.39 N
Long 24.52 W

Monday 8th

Came with gentle wind from the
N.W. and cloudy steering S.E. Mid & latter
gentle wind and thick mist at 8 A.M. saw school
of sperm whales below horizon and dark and dense
from two or three but finally got fast sail & set
boat fast

Tuesday 9th

Came with gentle wind from the S.E.
at 3 p.m. succeeded in getting three whales along side
and got ready and heave on at 7 p.m. got through
entire main sail steering S.E.
Mid part equally with rain. Latter part with fast rain
employed in clearing away the heads. Lat 8.00

Wednesday 10th

Came with gentle wind from the S.E. and
thick early at 5 p.m. started the works ship heading
South. Mid & latter part equally with some rain
heading South & long Lat 7.46 S
Long 25.38 W

Thursday 11th

Came with gentle wind from the S.E. and
some squally heading South at 6 A.M. got through
bailing. Mid & latter part gentle wind and some
squally with rain saw Blackfish heading S.W.
with all sail set. Lat 5.45 N
Long 25.00 W
