

Remarks on Board Ship

Tuesday January 18th 1848

First part light wind from the S.W. and fine weather steering S.E. with all sail out
 mid & latter part strong wind and thick fog
 S. by E

Wednesday 19th

First part gentle wind from the S.W. and thick fog steering S.E. mid & latter part fresh gale from the S.W. and thick rain at 12
 took in sail and shifted to S.E.

Thursday 20th

First part fresh gale from the S.W. and thick rain mid part heavy gale from the N.W. and clear latter part more moderate at sea and land for whales struck two got one boat left side and lost one line and took whales struck another and chased one from one to the other of whales in sight

Friday 21st

First part strong wind from the N.W. and rugged took in sail at 4 P.M. heard for whales struck two lost two lines and cut from the other came on board and took in sail mid & latter part strong wind and clear plenty of whales in sight at 10 heard and struck one and cut from the other took one and killed him S. by E. plenty of whales in sight

Saturday 22nd

First part fresh gale from the S.W. and rugged at 3 P.M. took the whale to the ship and the whale settled down under water so hid that could not look on clear up every thing and kept off to look in behind the chase and lost the whale & rugged to land that is our lastation whaling which 7 whales lost 100 of line 11 was one boat and some one boat hauled at 10 P.M. steering S.E. mid & latter strong wind and thick rain S. by E

Tuesday January 23rd 1848

First part strong wind from the S.W. and thick rain steering S.E. mid part fresh wind and thick latter part strong wind from the S.W. and thick rain
 S. by E

Monday 24th

First part strong wind from the S.W. and clear steering S.E. for camp with all sail out mid part gentle wind from the N.W. and clear latter part light wind from the S.W. and fine pleasant S.W. with all sail out under standing sail and S. by E

Lat 46. 27 Long 80. 06

Tuesday 25th

First part light wind from the S.W. and fine pleasant weather steering S.E. with all sail out mid part calm latter part gentle wind from the S.W. and clear heading S.E. S. by E Lat 46. 31

Wednesday 26th

Commenced with strong breeze from the S.W. and some thick heading S.E. S. by E mid part fresh gale from the S.W. and fresh rain later more moderate from the S.W. and clear steering S.E. Lat Long 85. 20

Thursday 27th

First part light wind from the S.W. and thick fog with a heavy swell on steering S.E. S. by E mid & latter part light wind from the S.W. and thick S. by E

Friday 28th

Commenced with gentle wind from the S.W. and some thick mid part strong latter part more moderate steering S.E. with all sail out
 S. by E
